

Ancestors of Anna Catherine Riedesel

Generation No. 1

1. Anna Catherine Riedesel, born April 22, 1815 in Wunderthausen; died September 11, 1909 in Oxford, New Jersey. She was the daughter of **2. Johann Ludwig Riedesel** and **3. Anna Elisabeth Knoche**. She married **(1) Johann Georg Riedesel** 1837 in Germany. He was born November 13, 1810 in Wunderthausen, and died 1894 in Oxford, New Jersey. He was the son of Johann Franz Riedesel and Anna Margarete Fuchs.

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. She had a total of eight children, but the names of two of them are unknown to me. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." I don't know if they were actually using that name.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. Born in Seimes/Weißkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1837. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They settled at Oxford, NJ (now Hazen). Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant. At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Homrighausen:

He was born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen. He inherited it from his father, but it may have had little if any agricultural land. In his early youth he was employed as a shepherd in neighboring Diedenshausen and then as teacher in the small settlements at Dachsloch and Langewiese. However, in 1833 he began what would be a lifetime of employment as one of the school teachers in Diedenshausen. His family continued to live in Wunderthausen (2km away), but during school he was only there two nights a week.

Originally, his compensation was mostly in grain though he was later paid a cash salary. It was meagre, and like most men in the region he pursued a side craft to help make ends meet. Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier

Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. I would guess that he came to Warren County, NJ, in the early 1840s, though it is possible that he came with his sister Catherine and brother-in-law in 1837. He (and the other Riedesels around Oxford) were called Radle or Riddle, but that may or may not have been their choice.

The Riddle spelling of the names of his children of the second marriage appears in the 1880 Census. I doubt that "Riedesel" was still in use, however. The 1900 Census uses "Riddle" for others of this group, and that is apparently the name that the family continued to use.

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen:

Born in Räderhaase/Haasebergers Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America in 1845, where he was known only as Franz. Before the founding of St. Paul's in 1861, he is recorded as a founding member of a German Reformed congregation or community (Gemeinde) in 1857. By the time of his death, he owned 536 acres of farmland at Wheatland.
