

## *Ancestors of Philipp Riedesel*

### *Generation No. 1*

**1. Philipp Riedesel**, born December 22, 1860 in Wunderthausen; died 1940. He was the son of **2. Georg Gabriel Riedesel** and **3. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche**. He married **(1) Augusta Hainer** 1881. She was born 1861 in Kansas City, and died 1940.

Notes for Philipp Riedesel:

Baptised as Phillip but known as Phillip John in this country. Came to the U.S. with his parents on the ship Argonaut out of Bremen. It arrived in New York on November 9, 1867. As an adult he lived in the Kansas City, Missouri area; in 1930 they lived in the Center township of Vernon County, MO. The 1930 Census lists his place of birth as Iowa, which is clearly false. It does suggest the possibility that his parents lived for a while around Wheatland. In the same Census, his son Phillip reported his father's birthplace as Missouri!

I find a 19-year old "John P Redzel" living with his widowed mother Elizabeth at Quindaro, Wyandotte County (Kansas City), Kansas in the 1880 Census. This is most likely Phillip John. Elizabeth's age is given as 49, which would be off by a few years.

Notes for Augusta Hainer:

Records suggest that her maiden name was actually Hoehner (Höhner). Mary Hainer, probably her spinster sister, was living with the family in Wyandotte/Quindaro in 1915.

### *Generation No. 2*

**2. Georg Gabriel Riedesel**, born September 20, 1809 in Wunderthausen; died before 1880 in Kansas City. He was the son of **4. Ludwig Riedesel** and **5. Maria Gertraud Dreisbach**. He married **3. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche** February 06, 1853 in Wunderthausen.

**3. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche**, born January 01, 1826 in Wunderthausen; died after 1880 in Kansas City. She was the daughter of **6. Johann Franz Knoche** and **7. Elisabeth Gertraud Strackbein**.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Riedesel:

Known as Ludwig. Established the house in Wunderthausen known as Schreiners/Großeludwigs. His two wives had the same birth names, but the first was apparently known as Maria and the second as Elisabeth. Ludwig came to America with his second wife and at least three children on the ship Argonaut out of Bremen. It arrived at New York on November 9, 1867.

The obituary of his son, Louis D. (from his first marriage), alludes to two half-sisters. One was Catherine and the other was probably the girl identified as "Dina" on the ship's manifest.

I find a 19-year old "John P Redzel" living with his widowed mother Elizabeth at Quindaro, Wyandotte County (Kansas City), Kansas in the 1880 Census. This is most likely Phillip John. Elizabeth's age is given as 49, which would be off by a few years.

**4. Ludwig Riedesel**, born October 21, 1766 in Wunderthausen; died September 02, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He was the son of **8. Johann Ludwig Riedesel** and **9. Elisabeth Gertraud Knoche**. He married **5. Maria Gertraud Dreisbach**.

**5. Maria Gertraud Dreisbach**, born January 14, 1771 in Melbach; died December 24, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She was the daughter of **10. Anton Dreisbach** and **11. Anna Maria Hackenbracht**.

Notes for Ludwig Riedesel:

Born in and tenant in Ludwigs Haus, Wunderthausen.

**6. Johann Franz Knoche**, born November 08, 1796 in Wunderthausen; died October 10, 1865 in Jackson County, MO. He was the son of **12. Johannes Knoche** and **13. Maria Amalia Womelsdorf**. He married **7. Elisabeth Gertraud Strackbein** December 23, 1821 in Wunderthausen.

**7. Elisabeth Gertraud Strackbein**, born October 12, 1804 in Wunderthausen; died June 09, 1891 in Jackson County, MO. She was the daughter of **14. Johann Theodorus Strackbein** and **15. Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen**.

Notes for Johann Franz Knoche:

Born in Seilers Haus, Wunderthausen, became tenant in Auf der Laye, but then went with his family to America. They had two daughters named Elisabeth Amalia, one born in 1822, one in 1826. One would assume that the first daughter died as an infant, but there is no death record in Wunderthausen.

The following is from "Vital Historical Records of Jackson County, Missouri 1826-1876" published in 1934 by the Kansas City Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, Kansas City, Missouri:

THE KNOCHE BURYING GROUND  
(Washington Township)

"The head of this family who came to America and to Jackson County, Missouri, a few years prior to the Civil War, was Johannes Franz KNOCHE, who with his wife, Elizabeth STROCHBINE KNOCHE, were born, reared and married in Prussia. Franz (Frank) KNOCHE was a soldier in the Prussian army before coming to America. In sections 28 and 29 in Washington Township the KNOCHE family purchased farm land in the locality known today as 140th and Holmes.

On this farm was a Family Burying Ground. This land was in the path of the fast-growing demand for smaller acreage and this old KNOCHE farm was sold. About the year 1916 "Jim" KNOCHE, a descendant of the immigrant ancestor, helped to remove all of the bodies which had been interred there, to the cemetery at Belton, Cass County, Missouri.

The following inscriptions were copied from the stones of members of this Jackson County family, which are found on the lot at the cemetery in Belton, Missouri:

"John KNOCHE, farmer and stock raiser, section 28, post-office New Santa Fe, was born in Prussia, September 7, 1828, and was there reared and educated. In the fall of 1858, he came to America, landing in New Orleans, and from there came to Jackson County, and is now the owner of 200 acres of improved land, with a fine residence. He was married in this county January 17, 1866, to Annie E. HOMRECHHOUSE. They have six children: Emily, John F., John R., Annie, Albert, and Nellie."

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen:

Came to America in 1866.

Orleans, and from there came to Jackson County, where he now owns ninety acres, with a good residence. He was married in this county, March 27, 1863, to Katie KNOCHE. They have six children: Katie, Henry, Louis, George, James and Omolaci."

Source: "The History of Jackson County, Missouri" published in 1881.

Born in the house Auf der Laye in Wunderthausen. Naturalized in 1858.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Knoche:

Known as Katherine or Katie in the U.S. She bore 9 children but I have names only of these 8. Emigrated in 1857 from Kellers house.

"Henry KNOCHE, farmer and stock raiser, section 29, post-office New Santa Fe, was born in Prussia, February 24, 1839, and was there reared and attended school, after which, in the fall of 1857, he came to America, landing in New York. He immediately came to this county and engaged in his present business, and now owns 385 acres of improved land, being an excellent stock farm. He was married in this county August 20, 1872, to Miss Amelia KUNZ. They have three children: Elizabeth, William H., and John C."

Source: "The History of Jackson County, Missouri" published in 1881.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Knoche:

It is an inference that she was the wife of Johann Philipp Knoche, and later Louis Tippe. The dates fit, and the odds favor her having married a fellow Wunderthäuser initially.

Notes for Johann Phillip Knoche:

Lived in the Kaw Township, Jackson County, Missouri. Came to the US on the ship Everhard out of Bremen, landing in Baltimore on May 25, 1841. Two of his brothers were also aboard.

- ix. Maria Catherine Knoche, born September 16, 1846 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Maria Catherine Knoche:

It is possible that she was the wife of Johannes Knoche (Kellers) and came with him to America in 1865 on the ship Hansa (Bremen to New York).

- x. Georg Ludwig Knoche, born May 19, 1850 in Wunderthausen; died September 05, 1897 in Cresent, Jackson County, MO; married Cornelia Jane Elsina Sturgin September 22, 1875 in Jackson County, MO; born January 20, 1859 in Allegheny County, NC.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Came to the U.S. with his parents in 1843 through the port of New Orleans. Lived near the town of Belton in Jackson County, MO. Owned 163 acres by 1881. His death certificate says he died of a fractured skull. A source says he was divorced at the time of his death.

"George KNOCHE, farmer, section 28, post-office Belton, is a native of Prussia, born May 19, 1850, and when seven years of age came with his parents to America, landing in New Orleans. From there he came to Jackson County, and after being reared and educated, commenced farming. He now owns 163 acres of well improved land, and his residence is nearly surrounded by shade trees. He was married September 22, 1875, to Miss Elsie STURGINN, of North Carolina. They have four children: Rose D., Dora E., Edward E., and Lee G."

Notes for Johann Gabriel Riedesel:  
Married into Weymers Haus from Gundermanns. Through his two marriages he is the progenitor of a large majority of Riedesels in the U.S. Most often referred to as J. Gabriel.
