Ancestors of Elisabeth Schumacher

Generation 1

 Elisabeth Schumacher, daughter of Daniel Schumacher and Susan Seanor, was born on October 02, 1831 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. She died on April 05, 1887 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel on November 21, 1854 in Galion, Crawford, Ohio. He was born on July 12, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 30, 1894 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel:

Known as L. Henry in America. Born in Haase Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to Crawford County, Ohio in 1845 with his parents, wife and two known children, three siblings, and the fiance of his brother, J. Ludwig, who came here in 1844. They arrived in New York on June 7, 1845. The families lived first near Galion, Ohio. An epidemic (presumably cholera or influenza, and certainly not "the plague") claimed the lives of the older couple, Henry's wife Amalia, and their daughter Anna. As of the 1850 census, he was living with his older son in the household of Franz and Anna Homrighausen. 2-year old John was living with the Christian Gerhardt family. Henry and Franz are listed as farmers though with no stated real estate value (they didn't own the land).

In 1852 (later than previously believed), Henry and his brother, George, walked from Ohio to lowa to purchase land. A Davenport-based land agent took them to the area that was to become Wheatland in the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County. Before returning to their families, they walked to lowa City to register the deeds. The story is that the land cost less than they expected so they could afford to return by river boat rather than walking; this took them down the Mississippi and then up the Ohio River. Henry and his family actually moved to Wheatland in 1855. The 100-year anniversary history of St. Paul's Church says that L. Henry and Elisabeth came in 1852 but this seems incorrect since Crawford County marriages say the marriage took place on November 21, 1854, which we will take as authoritative. Henry was naturalized on the same date--November 21, 1854--at Galion.

Others in the family bought land and moved to Wheatland. The town was officially founded in 1858 when the railroad came through. Prior to this time, it was very much an open frontier with limited communications and transportation to the outside world. Life was tenuous. In 1863-1864, several children from the Riedesel and Dürr families (and probably others) died of diphtheria.

Henry was a founder of the German Reformed Church in Wheatland (St. Paul's) and served as one of the first Trustees in 1861. He donated the initial half acre for the cemetery of St. Paul's Church. His land was to the north and east of Wheatland, and most of it has remained in family hands. Before the founding of St. Paul's in 1861, he is recorded as a founding member of a German Reformed congregation or community (Gemeinde) in 1857. In 1878, Henry built a new house to replace the cabin in which they had lived since coming to the area. He bought and sold land over the years but the core of his farm was in Section 10 of the Spring Rock Township immediately adjacent to Wheatland. He and two of his brothers were the only Wunderthausen emigrants to receive "patents" on their land, meaning they were the first (white) owners.

Generation 2

- 2. **Daniel Schumacher**, son of William Henry Schumacher and Anna Catharina Long, was born on July 21, 1800 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. He died on October 11, 1877 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County). He married **Susan Seanor**.
- 3. **Susan Seanor**, daughter of Christian Seanor and Mary Ann Fox, was born on January 03, 1809 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. She died on November 05, 1888 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County).

Notes for Daniel Schumacher:

The name is spelled Shoemaker in the 1850 Census but they were eventually buried as "Shumaker."

Susan Seanor and Daniel Schumacher had the following children:

- i. Elisabeth Schumacher was born on October 02, 1831 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. She died on April 05, 1887 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel on November 21, 1854 in Galion, Crawford, Ohio. He was born on July 12, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 30, 1894 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).
 - ii. David Shumaker was born on May 18, 1833 in Pennsylvania. He died on May 18, 1896 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County). He married Anna Elisabeth Schneider on June 07, 1902 in Newaygo, Michigan (This is a record of their son's marriage, not hers.). She was born on September 28, 1845 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 24, 1901 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County).

Notes for David Shumaker:

No children as of the 1870 Census when they were living with or adjacent to his parents outside of Galion. After 1870, I lose track of them.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Schneider:

Born in Altehäusers Haus in Wunderthausen. The family arrived in New York on the ship Amazone out of Bremen on May 31, 1848. She must have moved to Wheatland with her family as a child but ultimately married and lived back in Crawford County, Ohio. She only ever had the one child, George.

- iii. Mary Shumaker was born on September 14, 1837 in Ohio. She died on March 01, 1920 in Crawford County, Ohio.
- iv. William Schumacher was born on June 13, 1839 in Ohio. He died on April 08, 1915 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County).
- v. John Shumaker was born on June 08, 1844 in Ohio. He died on February 09, 1923 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County).

- 5. **Anna Catharina Long**, daughter of Caspar Lang and Maria Margretha ??, was born in 1764 in Tulpehocken, Berks, Pennsylvania. She died in 1830 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania (Saint Paul Seanor Cemetery).

- iv. Tobias Schumacher was born on October 03, 1796 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. He died on January 15, 1879 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. He married Elizabeth Horn on May 22, 1823. She was born on February 28, 1802 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. She died on July 31, 1881 in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.
- V. Elizabeth Schumacher was born on October 15, 1798 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. She died on October 18, 1863.

- vi. Daniel Schumacher was born on July 21, 1800 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. He died on October 11, 1877 in Crawford County, Ohio (Biddle Cemetery, Crawford County).  - ix. Adam Schumacher was born on January 26, 1808 in Hempfield, Westmoreland, Pennsylvania. He died on September 18, 1877 in Crawford County, Ohio (Windfall Cemetery, Crawford County). He married Catherine Stauffer. She was born on January 04, 1813 in Pennsylvania. She died on March 14, 1901 in Crawford County, Ohio (Windfall Cemetery, Crawford County).
- 6. **Christian Seanor** was born in 1758. He died in 1812. He married **Mary Ann Fox** in 1799.
- 7. **Mary Ann Fox** was born in 1767. She died in 1812.

- 8. **Johann Jost Schumacher**, son of Hans Wilhelm Schumacher and Anna Catharina Jacobs, was born in March 1716 in Elsoff. He died about 1787 in Berks County, Pennsylvania. He married **Anna Elisabeth ??** about 1745.
- 9. Anna Elisabeth ?? was born about 1725.

Notes for Johann Jost Schumacher:

Christened March 22, 1716 so was probably born shortly before. May have been the Jost Schumacher who arrived in Philadelphia on October 27, 1738 on the ship St. Andrew from Rotterdam via England (John Stedman, captain). Others with Wittgensteiner names were also aboard. He was almost certainly born in Gückers house in Elsoff. American records give his mother's name as Maria but his baptismal record says otherwise.

Strausstown Roots site (http://www.bergergirls.com) has extensive history from these families in Pennsylvania.

Anna Elisabeth ?? and Johann Jost Schumacher had the following children:

Notes for Christian Schumacher:

Arrived in the port of Philadelphia on Sept. 1, 1736 on the ship Harle.

Born in Ursesliegerländers house in Elsoff but married into Gückers house. He was almost certainly the son-in-law of the previous tenant there, Johann Henrich Gücker, but we have good records of his family with Anna Catharina Jacobs. I don't find a record of this first marriage.
