

**—DIED: Mr. Henry Riedesel, Sr.,** died at his home in Wheatland on Monday, July 30, at the age of 76 years. The funeral was held at 10 o'clock this morning, Rev. C. G. Zipf officiating. Deceased had been a long and patient sufferer and his death, though expected was a sad blow to relatives and friends. The remains were interred in the German cemetery and many followed them to their last resting place.
