

Ancestors of Heinrich Friedrich Riedesel

Generation No. 1

1. Heinrich Friedrich Riedesel, born January 11, 1856 in Wunderthausen; died September 19, 1931 in Osage County, KS. He was the son of **2. Georg Ludwig Riedesel** and **3. Maria Catherine Homrighausen**.

Notes for Heinrich Friedrich Riedesel:

He was born in Seimes house in Wunderthausen. It is likely that he was the "H Riedesel" who came to New York on October 4, 1881, aboard the ship Salier out of Bremen. The age matches (25), and he was accompanied by a Georg Strackbein (age 24), almost certainly from Kurts house in Wunderthausen.

As of 1900 and 1910 he was farming in Woodbury County, Iowa, not far from several Strackbein families. I can find no trace of him in the 1920 Census, but he is in Osage County, Kansas, in 1930. He never married.

Henry died Intestate, and an acquaintance from Burlingame was appointed to sell his possessions and settle debts. Henry owned less than 10 acres of land and a few miscellaneous goods. The probate records suggest that he had moved to Burlingame only in recent years. After paying outstanding debts, the executor had \$32.04 to distribute to five nephews and nieces (who had to be tracked down). Both of his sisters were deceased at the time of his death, or at least by the time his meager estate was settled in December 1933.

Notes for Florentine Riedesel:

Appears to have arrived in New York on the ship S. S. Donau out of Bremen on November 25, 1871, though years later she told a Census enumerator that she came in 1872. Several other passengers were from Wunderthausen. She apparently married a Heinrich Baumgartner first but had married Jacob Strable by 1880. In 1880, they were sharing a domicile in Oxford with her sister and brother-in-law. Three children from the Baumgartner family were living.

She bore a total of eight children by 1900, but only two--Henry and Anna Strable--were alive. I suspect she and her husband both died between 1910 and 1920.

Notes for Jacob Strable:

He came to the U.S. from Germany in 1873. His family name was probably something like Ströbel originally. Living next door to them in 1900 was the family of Henry "Strebel".

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Arrived in New York on the ship S. S. Donau out of Bremen on November 25, 1871. Several other passengers were from Wunderthausen. In 1880, she and her husband were sharing a domicile with her sister and her family. By 1900 she had borne seven children, but only four were living. I do not have the names of the other three. She is listed in the 1930 Census but was deceased by September 1931 when her brother Henry died.

Notes for Karl Busch:

He was known in this country as Charles Bush.

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen:

Resident in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. It was during his life time that the peasants of Wunderthausen were able (and required) to purchase their houses and land from the Sayn-Wittgenstein family that had ruled

Wittgenstein since the 1200s. This emancipation was a result of the Napoleonic Wars and subsequent Congress of Vienna in 1815 that concentrated the scores of small German states into a few larger ones.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. Born in Seimes/Weisßkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1837. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They settled at Oxford, NJ (now Hazen). Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant. At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations.

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. She had a total of eight children, but the names of two of them are unknown to me. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." I don't know if they were actually using that name.

He was born in Weymers Haus but married into Haase Haus. This was one of the smaller houses in the village. When they left in 1845, ownership of the house and land had finally been vested in the people, not the Count. What the terms of the sale were, we do not know. It was sold to J. Daniel Müsse from Jochums Haus. Ludwig and Florentine died around 1847-1848, possibly in an epidemic of cholera along with their daughter-in-law and at least one grandchild.

Notes for Florentine Althaus:

She was born in Haase Haus, which passed to her husband upon their marriage. Ludwig and Florentine died around 1847-1848, possibly in an epidemic of cholera along with their daughter-in-law and at least one grandchild.
