She died on December 24, 1927 in Waterloo, Allamakee, Iowa. She married Ernst John Guenther on August 23, 1894 in Denver, Bremer, Iowa. He was born on April 07, 1852 in Mecklenburg, Germany. He died on December 12, 1932 in Denver, Bremer, Iowa.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen:

Born in the house known variously as Bergmanns and Gabels. Family records say she was born in 1872, but the church records in Germany say 1873. Like many, she was called by her middle name.

Came to America on the ship "Lahn" out of Bremen, landing in the port of New York on September 14, 1893. She was in the company of a cousin, Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel, and the latter's son Christian Willi Riedesel of Wunderthausen. Father and son settled in Rochester as did Elisabeth for a while. However, she moved on to Iowa where many other relatives lived.

Generation 2

- 2. **Georg Wilhelm Homrighausen**, son of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Spies, was born on April 05, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1928 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Catharine Riedesel** on November 15, 1868 in Girkhausen.
- 3. **Anna Catharine Riedesel**, daughter of Gabriel Riedesel and Anna Elisabeth Müsse, was born on December 11, 1848 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 14, 1912 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Wilhelm Homrighausen:

Born in the house im Sohl but became the owner of Bergmanns/Gabels through marriage.

Anna Catharine Riedesel and Georg Wilhelm Homrighausen had the following children:

- i. Amalia Catherine Homrighausen was born on May 28, 1871 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on July 26, 1873 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 24, 1927 in Waterloo, Allamakee, Iowa. She married Ernst John Guenther on August 23, 1894 in Denver, Bremer, Iowa. He was born on April 07, 1852 in Mecklenburg, Germany. He died on December 12, 1932 in Denver, Bremer, Iowa.
 - iii. Wilhelm Ludwig Daniel Homrighausen was born on August 21, 1875 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 01, 1876 in Wunderthausen.
 - iv. Lisette Homrighausen was born on December 13, 1876 in Wunderthausen.
 - v. Hermine Homrighausen was born on April 01, 1880 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 31, 1953 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Mörchen on May 09, 1909. He was born on January 20, 1882 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1957.

Notes for Hermine Homrighausen: Bergmannsa/Gabels house passed to her and to her husband.

- vi. Wilhelm Homrighausen was born on August 06, 1884 in Wunderthausen.
- vii. Luise Homrighausen was born on March 29, 1887 in Wunderthausen.

Generation 3

- 4. **Johann Georg Homrighausen**, son of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Maria Magdalena Pott, was born on March 17, 1813 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 22, 1874 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Elisabeth Spies**.
- 5. **Anna Elisabeth Spies**, daughter of Johannes Spies and Anna Elisabeth Lauber, was born on April 26, 1810 in Girkhausen. She died on December 11, 1857 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen:

Inherited Langes Haus but sold it to build the house Im oberen Sohl.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Spies:

She seems to have been born in a house at Hoheleye, a hamlet belonging to Girkhausen.

Anna Elisabeth Spies and Johann Georg Homrighausen had the following children:

Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on May 20, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 21, 1909 in Black Hawk County, Iowa. He married Anna Elisabeth Müsse on April 17, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 10, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 20, 1865 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Riedesel on October 27, 1867. She was born on June 04, 1844 in Rehseifen. She died in 1916 in Iowa.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen:

Born in the house im Oberen Sohl, Wunderthausen. Shortly after his second marriage to Elisabeth Riedesel, he went to America--probably 1868, but I have not found an exact record. The German records say they went to Wheatland. However, the 1880 Census appears to place them in Bremer County where his occupation is that of a mason. The oldest daughter's birthplace was listed as Illinois. In 1900 they are near Waterloo in Black Hawk County.

The family adopted the spelling of Homrighaus.

Notes for Elisabeth Riedesel:

By 1900 she had borne ten children, of whom five were still alive. I cannot identify her parents, though the Wunderthausen record says her father was Ludwig Riedesel, a forest supervisor in nearby Rehseifen.

- ii. Maria Magdalena Homrighausen was born on May 21, 1838 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 12, 1838 in Wunderthausen.
- iii. Sophia Homrighausen was born on June 28, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 09, 1840.
- iv. Ludwig Homrighausen was born on April 27, 1843 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 07, 1843 in Wunderthausen.
- V. Georg Wilhelm Homrighausen was born on April 05, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1928 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Catharine Riedesel on November 15, 1868 in Girkhausen. She was born on December 11, 1848 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 14, 1912 in Wunderthausen.
 - vi. Jacob Heinrich Homrighausen was born on June 18, 1849 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 06, 1926 in Wunderthausen.
 - vii. Johannes Homrighausen was born on May 29, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 08, 1852 in Wunderthausen.
- 6. **Gabriel Riedesel**, son of Ludwig Riedesel and Maria Gertraud Dreisbach, was born on January 23, 1807 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 15, 1884 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Elisabeth Müsse** on October 31, 1830 in Wunderthausen.
- 7. **Anna Elisabeth Müsse**, daughter of Johann Philipp Müsse and Elisabeth Gertraud Dreisbach, was born on October 08, 1806 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 26, 1859 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Gabriel Riedesel: Tenant in Bergmans/Gabels Haus in Wunderthausen.

Anna Elisabeth Müsse and Gabriel Riedesel had the following children:

i. Wilhelmine Riedesel was born on October 22, 1829 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 26, 1897 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She married Johann Georg Schneider on June 24, 1848 in Bucyrus, Crawford, Ohio. He was born on December 13, 1825 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 14, 1883 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Wilhelmine Riedesel:

She was known as Minnie. Born in Gabels/Bergmanns Haus in Wunderthausen. She came to America with the J. Georg Schneider family--she married George Jr. The passenger manifest of the ship Amazone which arrived in New York on May 31, 1848 out of Bremen included a barely legible entry that I read as "Wilh Rittesel", age 20. The entry says "male mason" but mistakes were made.She married Johann Georg Schneider Jr. in Bucyrus, Ohio on June 24, 1848.

By 1851 the Schneiders had relocated to the Wheatland, Iowa area. Wilhelmine bore a total of 15 children. The first two were born in Ohio while the rest first saw the light of the world in Iowa. She was known as Minnie. They lived out their days there on a farm of 160 acres in Section 22 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County. George died there January 14, 1883 while Minnie died on January 26, 1897. Of course they are buried at St. Paul's Cemetery in Wheatland. They had an exceptionally large family but many children died as young adults.

Notes for Johann Georg Schneider:

Known as George, Jr. Born in Altehäusers Haus in Wunderthausen. The family arrived in New York on the ship Amazone out of Bremen on May 31, 1848. Came to Crawford County Ohio with his parents and siblings in 1848 and settled in what became Wheatland in 1851. Before the founding of St. Paul's in 1861, he is recorded as a founding member of a German Reformed congregation or community (Gemeinde) in 1857. His large farm was in Section 22 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County.

 Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel was born on July 23, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 17, 1898 in Carroll County, Iowa (East Liberty Cemetery, Lidderdale). He married Elisabeth Florentine Schneider about 1856 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She was born on January 20, 1841 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 09, 1920 in Lanesboro, Carroll, Iowa (East Liberty Cemetery, Lidderdale).

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel:

He was known as Henry in America. Born in Bergmanns/Gabels Haus, Wunderthausen. Came to the U.S. aboard the ship "Auguste" out of Bremen. It landed in New Orleans on October 25, 1854. According to family recollections, he worked his way up the Mississippi as a mason and well-digger until he reached Davenport, Iowa. He and Florentine Schneider (also from Wunderthausen) were married and had their children in Wheatland, but they moved on in 1891 to what became Lanesboro, Iowa in Carroll County.

I believe that he owned land in section18 of the Spring Rock Township around Wheatland; his farm in Carroll County was in section 2 of the Jasper Township.

Notes for Elisabeth Florentine Schneider:

Born in Altehäusers Haus in Wunderthausen. The family arrived in New York on the ship Amazone out of Bremen on May 31, 1848. Known as Florentine.

April 15, 1920 - Obituary of Grandma Riedesel - Mrs. Flora Riedesel passed away at her home in Lanesboro April 9th, at the age of 79 years, 2 months and 19 days, after a long illness. Although she was only confined to her bed a few hours. When she attempted to arise on the morning of her death she in some way fell and broke her hip. She suffered severely all day and passed away about 7 p.m.

Mrs. Riedesel was born in Germany and came to this county when 6 years of age and was married to Henry Riedesel in 1859. Mr. Riedesel preceded her twenty years ago. Twelve children were born to this union, ten of whom survive. They are: John and Hubert Riedesel, Mrs. Lizzie Miller, Mrs. Minnie Miller and Mrs. Clara Beckman, of Lanesboro; Peter of Wheatland; Paul, of Sioux City; Mrs. Hannah Cassum, of Sioux City; Philip, of Oklahoma; Mrs. Emma Vader, of Weiser, Idaho. All but the last two attended the funeral. There were twenty-seven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. Mrs. Riedesel came to Carroll county when the country was new and endured many hardships. Funeral services were held at the church Monday at 2 p.m. by Rev. Whear. A large crowd was present to pay their last respects to their old friend and neighbor. Interment at the East Liberty cemetery by the side of her husband. The floral offerings were beautiful. The family has the sympathy of the entire community in the loss of their mother.

- iii. Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel was born on December 25, 1836 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 01, 1900 in Diedenshausen. She married Friedrich Peter on April 07, 1861 in Diedenshausen. He was born on May 14, 1830 in Diedenshausen. He died on October 12, 1915 in Diedenshausen.
- iv. Infant Riedesel was born on October 05, 1838 in Wunderthausen.
- v. Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born on January 07, 1840 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 01, 1913 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Wilhelmine Elisabeth Peter on February 25, 1866 in Diedenshausen. She was born on March 06, 1842 in Diedenshausen. She died on June 29, 1909 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel:

Known as Louis C. and as "Charley" in the U.S. though his obituary in the Wheatland Gazette calls him "Ludwig Carl." Born in Bergmanns/Gabels Haus in Wunderthausen where he was baptised as "Georg Ludwig." The family story is that he was a soldier in the Franco-Prussian war, but that is not possible as he emigrated in 1867 and that war took place 1870-1871. He presumably participated in the "Danish" war of 1863-64 and/or the Austro-Prussian war of 1866. He belonged to a German veterans association in nearby Lowden, Iowa. Came to America on the ship Humboldt, which traveled from Bremen to New York and landed on May 27, 1867.

They lived in Cedar County near Lowden, which is close to Big Rock as well. He eventually owned at least 160 acres in Section 24 of the Springfield Township (Cedar County). Their son Ernest continued to farm this land, followed by Ernest's sons Ernest and Harold. The farm itself was known locally as the Cambridge farm and they were referred to as the "Cambridge Riedesels."

Notes for Wilhelmine Elisabeth Peter:

Known as Katherine. Other sources give her year of birth as 1838, but that is in error. She was born in Wagners Haus, Diedenshausen. Apparently, she and her husband lived in Diedenshausen before going to America. Came on the ship Humbold with her family, which traveled from Bremen to New York and landed on May 27, 1867. Her obituary says she bore 14 children, three of whom preceded her in death. The 14th was probably an infant whose name has not come down to us.

- vi. Johann Friedrich Wilhelm Riedesel was born on April 30, 1842 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 21, 1843 in Wunderthausen.
- vii. Anna Elisabeth Riedesel was born on April 30, 1842 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 07, 1917 in Irondequoit, Monroe, New York (Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester). She married Johann Jacob Baetzel on August 24, 1869 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Zion Lutheran Church-Rochester). He was born on July 01, 1845 in Elsoff. He died on January 29, 1929 in Lockport, New York, USA.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Riedesel:

Born in Bergmanns/Gabels Haus in Wunderthausen. It appears that she as a twin according to my very best source. She is absent, though, from other transcriptions I have from the Wunderthausen records. Came to the U.S. in 1867 as a passenger on the ship Albert out of Bremen It landed in New York May 10, 1867.

Also on board was her future husband and several others with recognizable Wittgenstein names. She and a younger sister were both christened "Anna Elisabeth." I think she was the one called Elisabeth.

Notes for Johann Jacob Baetzel: Born in the village of Elsoff. Came to the U.S. on the ship Albert out of Bremen, arriving in New York on May 10, 1867.

- viii. Catharina Riedesel was born on September 28, 1844 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 26, 1847 in Wunderthausen.
- ix. Anna Elisabeth Riedesel was born on December 10, 1846 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 10, 1900 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester). She married Jacob Schüssler on May 19, 1870 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Trinity Evangelical Church-Rochester). He was born on December 20, 1838 in Elsoff. He died on March 29, 1932 in Cleveland, Ohio (Highland Park Cemetery, Cuyahoga Ohio).

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Riedesel:

Born in Bergmanns/Gabels Haus in Wunderthausen. It is likely that she is the Anna Riedesel who arrived on the ship Marco Polo in New York on October 30, 1868. She and her husband lived in Rochester where they had a total of six children. The name of one is not known to me.

Notes for Jacob Schüssler:

He was an optician. Came to New York in 1867 on the ship "D. H. Wagen" out of Bremen.

- x. Anna Catharine Riedesel was born on December 11, 1848 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 14, 1912 in Wunderthausen. She married Georg Wilhelm Homrighausen on November 15, 1868 in Girkhausen. He was born on April 05, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1928 in Wunderthausen.
 - xi. Johann Daniel Riedesel was born on March 01, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 31, 1929 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester). He married Louisa Mengel on May 18, 1876 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Salem Evangelical Church-Rochester). She was born about April 1857 in Rochester, Monroe, New York. She died on June 22, 1888 in Rochester, New York, USA (Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester). He married Elizabeth Mehne on September 04, 1889 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Salem Evangelical Church-Rochester). She was born on October 02, 1859 in New York. She died on March 15, 1940 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Mount Hope Cemetery, Rochester).

Notes for Johann Daniel Riedesel:

Born in Bergmanns/Gabels Haus in Wunderthausen. Exactly when he came to the U.S. is unclear as he gave widely disparate dates in the Census records I can find. His first marriage date of 1876 in Rochester is firm.

Lived in Rochester, New York, where he owned a restaurant in the German community. Known as John. His obituary in the Rochester Democrat & Chronicle is uninformative. He was a member of several lodges and the Salem Church. No mention was made of his German origins or even his age.

Notes for Elizabeth Mehne:

Her 1910 Census entry says she had borne a total of six children but that only three were then alive.

- 8. **Johann Georg Homrighausen**, son of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel, was born on February 09, 1786 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 19, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Magdalena Pott** on January 15, 1801 in Wunderthausen.
- 9. **Maria Magdalena Pott**, daughter of Johannes Pott and Maria Elisabeth Klein, was born on November 08, 1781 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 08, 1850 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen: Tenant in Neues Brückehaus/Langes. Found frozen to death.

Notes for Maria Magdalena Pott: Born in Mannes Haus.

Maria Magdalena Pott and Johann Georg Homrighausen had the following children:

 Johann Philipp Homrighausen was born on August 07, 1805 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 28, 1885 in Denver, Bremer, Iowa (Fairview Cemetery, Denver, Iowa). He married Helene Magdelena Germann. She was born on September 28, 1819 in Germany. She died on October 12, 1857 in Schaumberg, Cook, Illinois.

Notes for Johann Philipp Homrighausen:

Born in Langes Haus in Wunderthausen. Went to America in the Apollo, landing in New York out of Bremen on July 7, 1835. He was another of those whose children modified the family name. There were other Wunderthäuser who settled in Denver, Iowa, but this family spent a lot of time in Ohio first.

ii. Georg Ludwig Homrighausen was born on January 03, 1808 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 19, 1885 in Stone Creek, Tuscarawas, Ohio.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen:

He was born in Langes Haus in Wunderthausen. Records show that he went to America on the ship "Themis" which landed in Baltmore out of Bremen on July 24, 1834.

There is some false information out there about him. It was not him who fathered a child by Catherine Magdalena Weller back in Wunderthausen, but a Georg Hermann Homrighausen. Nor is there a baptismal record for a daughter Elisabeth (or anyone else!) born in Wunderthausen on July 20, 1834. If he did marry an Elisabeth Alderman, she was not a Wittgensteiner. An Elisabeth Homrighausen married a Cronebach and had a family, but I am not at all certain of the relationships.

- iii. Johannes Homrighausen was born on October 06, 1810 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on March 17, 1813 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 22, 1874 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Spies. She was born on April 26, 1810 in Girkhausen. She died on December 11, 1857 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Katharina Lauber on May 16, 1858. She was born on July 23, 1818 in Hoheleye, Girkhausen (Girkhausen). She died on September 26, 1869 in Wunderthausen.
 - v. Ludwig Heinrich Homrighausen was born on February 26, 1821 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 09, 1855 in Tuscarawas County, Ohio (Mud Run Cemetery, Tuscarawas). He married Julia Kinsey about 1844 in Ohio. She was born in 1821 in Switzerland.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Homrighausen: Born in Neus Brückehaus/Langes in Wunderthausen. Received permission to come to America in 1841 but we don't have a ship's record for him. He settled in Tuscarawas County, Ohio His children and their descendants modified the family name.

Notes for Julia Kinsey: She had at least one previous marriage.

- Johannes Spies, son of Johann Georg Spies and Anna Gertraud Pott, was born on August 28, 1757 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 29, 1820 in Girkhausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Lauber on March 23, 1787.
- 11. **Anna Elisabeth Lauber**, daughter of Johannes Lauber and Anna Elisabeth Rühl, was born on November 15, 1767 in Girkhausen. She died on April 22, 1828.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Lauber: She lived in a house at Hoheleye, a hamlet belonging to Girkhausen. Her husband was from Wunderthausen but married into this house.

Anna Elisabeth Lauber and Johannes Spies had the following child:

- Anna Elisabeth Spies was born on April 26, 1810 in Girkhausen. She died on December 11, 1857 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Homrighausen. He was born on March 17, 1813 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 22, 1874 in Wunderthausen.
- 12. Ludwig Riedesel, son of Johann Ludwig Riedesel and Elisabeth Gertraud Knoche, was born on October 21, 1766 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 02, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Gertraud Dreisbach.
- 13. **Maria Gertraud Dreisbach**, daughter of Anton Dreisbach and Anna Maria Hackenbracht, was born on January 14, 1771 in Melbach. She died on December 24, 1831 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Riedesel:

Born in Ludwigs Haus, Wunderthausen but founded the house that was known as Großeludwigs. Maria Gertraud Dreisbach and Ludwig Riedesel had the following children:

- i. Elisabeth Gertraud Riedesel was born on December 20, 1791 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. Johann Georg Riedesel was born on January 12, 1793 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 07, 1799 in Wunderthausen.
- iii. Johann Jost Riedesel was born on July 11, 1795 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 08, 1873 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen on October 08, 1827 in Wunderthausen. She was born on September 23, 1802 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 12, 1872 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Jost Riedesel: Born in Ludwigs Haus/Unter der Laye but took over Altehäusers when the Schneiders went to America. The house became known as Hanjosts (from his name).

- Anna Elisabeth Riedesel was born on October 17, 1800 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 25, 1857 in Wunderthausen. She married Johannes Benfer. He was born on January 12, 1800.
- v. Maria Amalia Riedesel was born on August 11, 1803 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 06, 1827 in Wunderthausen.
- vi. Gabriel Riedesel was born on January 23, 1807 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 15, 1884 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Müsse on October 31, 1830 in Wunderthausen. She was born on October 08, 1806 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 26, 1859 in Wunderthausen.
 - vii. Georg Gabriel Riedesel was born on September 20, 1809 in Wunderthausen. He died before 1880 in Clay County, Kansas. He married Elisabeth Amalia Knoche on August 24, 1834 in Wunderthausen. She was born on November 08, 1807 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 26, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Amalia Knoche on February 06, 1853 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 01, 1826 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 17, 1880 in Kansas City, Jackson, Missouri.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Riedesel:

Known as Ludwig. Born in the house "Ludwigs unter der Leye" but established the house in Wunderthausen known as Schreiners/Großeludwigs. His two wives had the same birth names, but the first was apparently known as Maria and the second as Amalia. Ludwig came to America with his second wife and at least

three children on the ship Argonaut out of Bremen. It arrived at New York on November 9, 1867. We have newspaper advertisements that he placed in Wittgenstein in the summer of 1867 putting the house, property and harvest up for sale. He owned less than three acres of cropland and a couple pieces of pasture land.

The obituary of his son, Louis D. (from his first marriage), alludes to two halfsisters. One was Catherine and the other was probably the girl identified as "Dina" on the ship's manifest. The latter was--I believe--a common nickname for "Christine." Yet I find no record of her in the Wunderthausen records.

A recent history from Wunderthausen lists a death date in May 1884. However, I find no trace of Ludwig in the 1880 Census but his supposedly widowed wife is living with their son, Phillip.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Knoche: Born in the house "Auf der Leye" (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen.

Whether it was she or her younger sister Elisabeth Florentine (b. 1831) who married Georg Gabriel (Ludwig) Riedesel is not clear. Researchers in Germany have interpreted the records to say that It was Elisabeth Florentine. However, the marriage record just says "Elisabeth Knoche" so it could be either one. The ship's list in 1867 gives her age as 42 (so born about 1825 and fitting the older sister). The 1870 Census gives her age as 44, matching the older sister's birth year of 1826. Only in 1880 did the widow give her age as 49 (an implied birth year of 1831). It is my judgment that Elisabeth Amalia (b. 1826) was the bride.

"Rittase" sounds very much like the Wittgenstein pronunciation of "Riedesel" except for dropping the final "L". Everyone with this name appears to trace back to John.
