He married Euphemia Goudie on October 01, 1894 in Miami, Kansas. She was born on September 18, 1871 in Miami County, Kansas. She died in 1935.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Homrighausen: Born in Bormanns house, Wunderthausen and came to America in 1882 where he was known as George J. They lived in the Valley Township of Miami County, Kansas.

Generation 2

- 2. **Georg Ludwig Homrighausen**, son of Johann Franz Homrighausen and Maria Elisabeth Riedesel, was born on April 02, 1828 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 29, 1914 in Miami County, Kansas. He married **Elisabeth Amalia Knoche** on April 12, 1857 in Wunderthausen.
- 3. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche, daughter of Johannes Knoche and Anna Elisabeth Weller, was born on October 27, 1832 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 16, 1904 in Miami County, Kansas.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen:

Born in Linde house, Wunderthausen, but took over Bormanns. His biography relates that he came (alone) to the U.S. in 1850 and settled in Illinois. But he then returned to Germany ("in the latter 50s") and went on to serve in both the Danish (1864) and Austrian (1866) wars with the Prussian army. The entire family emigrated to Miami County, Kansas in 1882 or 1883 but we are unsure of what ship they took.

The obituary implies that he left a wife behind in 1850. He and Elisabeth Amalia were married in Germany in 1857. Their first daughter was definitely born in 1853 (before their marriage) in Wunderthausen. He must only have stayed a couple of years in the U.S. the first time.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Knoche:

Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen where she was married. The family came to America in 1883 though I have not found exact passenger information about them.

Elisabeth Amalia Knoche and Georg Ludwig Homrighausen had the following children:

i. Catherine Homrighausen was born on December 12, 1853 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1939 in Miami County, Kansas. She married Johannes Knoche on March 03, 1879. He was born on March 19, 1846 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 15, 1920 in Miami County, Kansas.

Notes for Catherine Homrighausen:

Born in Bormanns house in Wunderthausen. She came to New York on the ship "Donau" on November 25, 1871. Was in the company of Wunderthausen emigrants.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Arrived in New Orleans on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen on October 13, 1857. Known as James. Came to America with his father. Lived first in Jackson County, Missouri, came to Paola, Kansas in 1861. In 1879 he bought farmland near the town of Valley.

ii. Christine Homrighausen was born on March 14, 1858 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 16, 1914 in Miami County, Kansas. She married Heinrich Homrighausen on November 30, 1879 in Wunderthausen. He was born on December 07, 1854 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 09, 1926 in Miami County, Kansas. She married an unknown spouse on November 29, 1879 in Germany. Notes for Christine Homrighausen:

Known as Dina. Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen which her husband then took over. They came to America on the ship "Donau" out of Bremen, landing in New York on November 20, 1885. She had a total of nine children but only five were alive in 1900.

Notes for Heinrich Homrighausen:

Born in Wetzels house, Wunderthausen but took over Bormanns when he married Christine (Dina). Arrived in New York on the Donau on November 20, 1885 out of Bremen with their children "Dina" and Heinrich. Three other young women from Wunderthausen were on board including a third "Dina" Homrighausen. Later Census records give 1886 as their immigration date but that is incorrect. Settled in Miami County, Kansas.

iii. Georg Ludwig Homrighausen was born on June 11, 1860 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1932 in Miami County, Kansas. He married Amalia Strackbein on January 07, 1891 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. She was born on September 25, 1867 in Wheatland Clinton, Iowa. She died on April 30, 1945 in Osawatomie, Miami, Kansas.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen:

Born in Bormanns house, Wunderthausen. Known as Louis. Came to America with his parents on the ship Salier out of Bremen which landed in New York on October 4, 1881. The family lived at Osawatomie, Miami County, Kansas.

His birth year is recorded as 1859 in some places but the German church records say 1860.

 iv. Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on October 27, 1862 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 11, 1946 in Glendale, Saline, Kansas. She married Johann Christian Bieber on November 20, 1888. He was born on December 15, 1844 in Germany. He died on June 19, 1925.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen:

Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America on the ship Neckar out of Bremen, landing in New York on May 29, 1880. Known as Anna.

v. Maria Amalia Homrighausen was born on December 20, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1932 in Kaw, Jackson County, Missouri, United States of America. She married Johann Franz Knoche on August 05, 1884 in Miami, Kansas. He was born on July 01, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died in September 1920 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.

Notes for Maria Amalia Homrighausen:

Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America on the ship Köln out of Bremerhaven arriving in Baltimore April 10, 1881. Known as Amelia.

Notes for Johann Franz Knoche:

Known as John in America. He was recorded as the out-of-wedlock child of his mother in Schäfers Haus in Wunderthausen with no notation as to who the father was. Three years later his mother went to America with some others from Wunderthausen and eventually married Georg Ludwig Knoche from that party. While he may or may not have been the father of the child, John took the name Knoche. By his own report, he came to America in 1867 long after his mother. As of 1900 they were living with their children on the farm of his parents (close the George W. Homrighausen farm).

 vi. Johann Heinrich Homrighausen was born on March 14, 1867 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1948 in Kansas. He married Euphemia Goudie on October 01, 1894 in Miami, Kansas. She was born on September 18, 1871 in Miami County, Kansas. She died in 1935. vii. Ludwig Heinrich Homrighausen was born on March 14, 1869 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 24, 1905 in Miami County, Kansas.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Homrighausen: Born in Bormanns house, Wunderthausen. Known as Henry. That is all I know.

- viii. Johann Wilhelm Homrighausen was born on February 24, 1871 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 22, 1871 in Wunderthausen.
- ix. Lisette Homrighausen was born on July 22, 1874 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 04, 1874 in Wunderthausen.

Generation 3

- 4. **Johann Franz Homrighausen**, son of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Juliana Catherine Gertraud Dienst, was born on February 05, 1806 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 18, 1878 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Elisabeth Riedesel** on April 18, 1830 in Wunderthausen.
- 5. **Maria Elisabeth Riedesel**, daughter of Johann Franz Riedesel and Anna Margarete Fuchs, was born on April 14, 1806 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 24, 1873 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen:

Resident in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. It was during his life time that the peasants of Wunderthausen were able (and required) to purchase their houses and land from the Sayn-Wittgenstein family that had ruled Wittgenstein since the 1200s. This emancipation was a result of the Napoleonic Wars and subsequent Congress of Vienna in 1815 that concentrated the scores of small German states into a few larger ones.

Maria Elisabeth Riedesel and Johann Franz Homrighausen had the following children:

- i. Georg Ludwig Homrighausen was born on April 02, 1828 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 29, 1914 in Miami County, Kansas. He married Elisabeth Amalia Knoche on April 12, 1857 in Wunderthausen. She was born on October 27, 1832 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 16, 1904 in Miami County, Kansas.
 - ii. Anna Catherine Homrighausen was born on February 01, 1832 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 20, 1903 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Heinrich Lauber on November 27, 1859 in Wunderthausen. He was born on February 27, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 30, 1866 in Wunderthausen. She married Georg Wilhelm Lauber on December 06, 1868 in Wunderthausen. He was born on May 13, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 27, 1876 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Anna Catherine Homrighausen: Her second husband was the younger brother of her late first husband. This kept the property (Beitzels Haus) in the family.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Lauber: Lived in Beitzels Haus in Wunderthausen.

- iii. Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on January 18, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 07, 1847 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Heinrich Homrighausen was born on June 16, 1838 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 14, 1900 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Katherine Lauber on December 18, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She was born on September 22, 1835 in Wunderthausen (Rehseifen). She died on May 04, 1905 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Heinrich Homrighausen:

He succeeded his father as the owner of Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. It remains in the Homrighausen family. A great-grandson was the last Bürgermeister in Wunderthausen; that office was abolished in a governmental re-organization in the 1970s.

v. Georg Franz Homrighausen was born on July 17, 1840 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 04, 1916 in Lewis County, Missouri (Mount Pleasant

Cemetery/Lewis County). He married Mary Steffen before 1875. She was born on January 11, 1855 in Steffenville, Lewis County, Missouri. She died on February 15, 1880 in Steffenville, Lewis County, Missouri (Mount Pleasant Cemetery/Lewis County). He married Caroline Steffen on August 26, 1880 in Lewis, Missouri. She was born on September 19, 1861 in Steffenville, Lewis County, Missouri. She died on February 16, 1928 in Lewis County, Missouri.

Notes for Georg Franz Homrighausen:

Born in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. He was known as Frank. He eventually settled on a farm in the Salem township of Lewis County, Missouri. According to family tradition, he served in the Prussian army prior to his emigration. His wives were sisters.

Notes for Caroline Steffen: She bore at least two more children who died before 1900.

- vi. Anna Maria Dina Homrighausen was born on July 15, 1845 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 18, 1858 in Wunderthausen.
- vii. Maria Catherine Homrighausen was born on June 21, 1850 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 16, 1919 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Ludwig Strackbein on June 06, 1875 in Wunderthausen. He was born on July 28, 1852 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 24, 1915 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Strackbein: Born in and became the owner of Gundermanns Haus in Wunderthausen.

- 6. **Johannes Knoche**, son of Georg Gabriel Knoche and Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen, was born on March 14, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 14, 1885 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Elisabeth Weller** on February 21, 1830 in Wunderthausen.
- 7. **Anna Elisabeth Weller**, daughter of Daniel Weller, was born in 1806 in Diedenshausen. She died on December 10, 1834 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Born in Bormanns house in Wunderthausen, and became the tenant/owner. The second marriage ended in divorce, and the mother apparently went to America with Caroline.

Anna Elisabeth Weller and Johannes Knoche had the following child:

 Elisabeth Amalia Knoche was born on October 27, 1832 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 16, 1904 in Miami County, Kansas. She married Georg Ludwig Homrighausen on April 12, 1857 in Wunderthausen. He was born on April 02, 1828 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 29, 1914 in Miami County, Kansas.

Generation 4

- 8. **Johann Georg Homrighausen**, son of Sebastian Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Pott, was born on July 15, 1762 in Diedenshausen. He died on December 03, 1825 in Wunderthausen. He married **Juliana Catherine Gertraud Dienst** on July 18, 1802.
- 9. **Juliana Catherine Gertraud Dienst**, daughter of Johann Franz Dienst and Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen, was born on January 27, 1784 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 17, 1853.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen:

Born in Hermes house, Diedenshausen, married into Linde house in Wunderthausen.

Juliana Catherine Gertraud Dienst and Johann Georg Homrighausen had the following children:

- i. Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on December 16, 1803 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 27, 1877 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel: Lived in Seimes Haus, Wunderthausen.

v. Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on February 08, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 12, 1883 in Wunderthausen. She married Johannes Lauber on July 06, 1834. He was born on December 25, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 28, 1859 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Lauber: Born in and lived in Hohmanns house, Wunderthausen.

- vi. Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen was born on December 12, 1813 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 11, 1814 in Wunderthausen.
- vii. Georg Ludwig Homrighausen was born on January 06, 1816 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 08, 1887 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Magdalena Riedesel on September 18, 1842 in Wunderthausen. She was born on July 07, 1824 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 26, 1898 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen: Took over Wetzels house though born in Linde.

viii. Johannes Homrighausen was born on August 23, 1819 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 04, 1898 in Red Bud, Randolph, Illinois.

Notes for Johannes Homrighausen:

Born in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. He came to America in 1845 on the ship Minna with other people from Wunderthausen. Known here as John. Lived and worked on his brother Henry's farm; never married.

ix. Johann Heinrich Homrighausen was born on April 20, 1822 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 05, 1881 in Red Bud, Randolph, Illinois (St. Marcus Cemetery, Monroe County). He married Sophia Scharch in 1847. She was born on December 07, 1825 in Darmstadt. She died on October 02, 1887 in Red Bud, Randolph, Illinois.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Homrighausen: Born in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen. Went to America in 1841. He reportedly lived first in St. Louis, then in Kansas City, then back to St. Louis before buying land in Monroe County, Illinois near Red Bud in 1854.

- 10. **Johann Franz Riedesel**, son of Johannes Riedesel and Maria Elisabeth Dienst, was born on August 21, 1774 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 14, 1843 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Margarete Fuchs** on December 11, 1800 in Wunderthausen.
- 11. **Anna Margarete Fuchs**, daughter of Johann Ludwig Fuchs and Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen, was born on January 11, 1777 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Franz Riedesel: Born in Weymers Haus but became the tenant in Seimes.

Anna Margarete Fuchs and Johann Franz Riedesel had the following children:

i. Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born on February 15, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 07, 1878 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Catherine Homrighausen on April 18, 1830 in Wunderthausen. She was born on April 01,

1810 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 11, 1870 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel: Lived in Seimes Haus, Wunderthausen.

- ii. Catherine Elisabeth Riedesel was born on July 17, 1803 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 04, 1805 in Wunderthausen.
- iii. Maria Elisabeth Riedesel was born on April 14, 1806 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 24, 1873 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Franz Homrighausen on April 18, 1830 in Wunderthausen. He was born on February 05, 1806 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 18, 1878 in Wunderthausen. She married ??.
 - iv. Johann Georg Riedesel was born on November 13, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 31, 1894 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Anna Catherine Riedesel in 1837. She was born on April 22, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 11, 1909 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Born in Seimes/Weisßkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1834. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They went to America and settled at Oxford, New Jersey (now Hazen) in 1837; the name of their ship or exact travel dates are not known. Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant.

At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations. Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. A transcription of the New Jersey death record lists him as "J. George Riddle." That source gives his year of death as 1893. His grave marker says 1884. Other family trees say 1894 which I am accepting for now but any of the dates is possible.

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." In other sources it is listed as Radle.

She appears to have been known as Mary Catherine.

- 12. **Georg Gabriel Knoche**, son of Johannes Knoche and Elisabeth Gertraud Pott, was born on August 30, 1773 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 17, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He married **Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen** on May 29, 1798 in Wunderthausen.
- 13. **Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen**, daughter of Johann Georg Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Knebel, was born on November 21, 1773 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 01, 1833 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Knoche: Born in and was the tenant in Bormann Haus.

Notes for Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen: There is confusion in the church records about Elisabeth and her twin, Catherine. The death record refers to Catherine, the wife of Georg Gabriel Knoche. Yet baptismal records of the

Catherina Elisabeth Homrighausen and Georg Gabriel Knoche had the following children:

children consistently refer to Georg Gabriel and Elisabeth Gertraudt as the parents.

i. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche was born on November 28, 1796 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 21, 1847 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Fuchs on October 03, 1824 in Wunderthausen. He was born on February 08, 1792 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 23, 1834 in Wunderthausen. Notes for Johann Georg Fuchs: Master joiner, born in Seimes house. Took over Lotzes house which from then on was known as Fuchs house.

ii. Johannes Knoche was born on April 18, 1799 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Knoche: Born in Bormanns house, Wunderthausen.

- iii. Johannes Knoche was born on March 14, 1801 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 14, 1885 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Amalia Knoche on May 17, 1835 in Wunderthausen. She was born on February 01, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died before 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married Anna Elisabeth Weller on February 21, 1830 in Wunderthausen. She was born in 1806 in Diedenshausen. She died on December 10, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Krohe on March 03, 1839 in Wunderthausen. She was born about 1813 in Wemlighausen. She died on January 30, 1856.
 - iv. Johann Georg Knoche was born on January 13, 1805 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 07, 1859 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Amalia Strackbein on July 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She was born on September 29, 1814 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 17, 1880 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Johann Georg Knoche: Brückeweimers.

Notes for Maria Amalia Strackbein:

Born in Schäfers house, Wunderthausen. Arrived in New York on the ship S. S. Donau out of Bremen on November 25, 1871. She had been widowed for more than ten years. Several other passengers were from Wunderthausen including her daughter Florentine. I do not know where she lived but it was almost certainly with one or more of her children.

v. Georg Ludwig Knoche was born on October 10, 1809 in Wunderthausen. He died in Probably in America. He married Maria Magdalena Schneider. She was born on August 30, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 30, 1845 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. He traveled with some relatives to the port of New Orleans on the ship Diana in 1841. It is most likely that he joined relatives in the Kansas City area but I have no other information. Daughter Elisabeth used the family name of Knoche even though the parents were not married.

14. Daniel Weller was born in Diedenshausen.

Daniel Weller had the following child:

 Catharina Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on October 10, 1751 in Diedenshausen. She died on February 13, 1824 in Diedenshausen. Notes for Johannes Homrighausen: Born in and tenant in Hermes Haus, Diedenshausen.
