She died on July 17, 1909 in Warren County, New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). She married Johannes Strackbein on March 10, 1872 in Wunderthausen. He was born on June 02, 1845 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 17, 1933 in New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).

Notes for Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen: Born in Brückeschneiders Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to the U.S. with her husband in 1872.

Notes for Johannes Strackbein: Born in Mannes Haus, Wunderthausen. Emigrated to Oxford, New Jersey in 1872 according to the 1920 Census. As of 1880 he was working at a blast furnace. Naturalized 1877.

- 2. **Johann Ludwig Homrighausen**, son of Johannes Homrighausen and Maria Magdalena Homrighausen, was born on March 22, 1804 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 03, 1878 in Wunderthausen. He married **Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel** on July 11, 1836 in Wunderthausen.
- 3. **Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel**, daughter of Johann Ludwig Riedesel and Anna Elisabeth Knoche, was born on January 27, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 25, 1897 in Wunderthausen.

# Notes for Johann Ludwig Homrighausen:

He was born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen. He inherited it from his father, but it may have had little if any agricultural land. In his early youth he was employed as a shepherd in neighboring Diedenshausen and then as teacher in the small settlements at Dachsloch and Langewiese. However, in 1833 he began what would be a lifetime of employment as one of the school teachers in Diedenshausen. His family continued to live in Wunderthausen (2km away), but during school he was only there two nights a week.

Originally, his compensation was mostly in grain though he was later paid a cash salary. It was meagre, and like most men in the region he pursued a side craft to help make ends meet. Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier

Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel and Johann Ludwig Homrighausen had the following children:

- i. Catherine Wilhelmine Homrighausen was born on July 20, 1837 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 26, 1860 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. Georg Ludwig Homrighausen was born on March 12, 1839 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 04, 1839 in Wunderthausen.
- iii. Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on February 11, 1842 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 03, 1918 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Lauber on December 03, 1871. He was born on May 30, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 20, 1882 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Homrighausen: She lived to see her oldest and youngest sons die in the Great War.

Notes for Johann Georg Lauber: Lived in Hohmanns house.

iv. Ludwig Homrighausen was born on June 28, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 14, 1921 in Wunderthausen. He married Katharina Strackbein on July 19,

1874. She was born on November 14, 1853 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 10, 1881 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Catherine Homrighausen on July 23, 1882. She was born on July 12, 1860 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 08, 1939.

Notes for Ludwig Homrighausen: Lived in Brückeschneiders house.

v. Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen was born on February 21, 1848 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 13, 1911 in Idalia, Yuma, Colorado. She married Georg Ludwig Homrighausen about 1875 in Iowa City, Johnson, Iowa. He was born on September 15, 1848 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 26, 1917 in Idalia, Yuma, Colorado.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen:

Born in Brückeschneiders Haus in Wunderthausen. She came to America on the "Argonaut" out of Bremen with other people from Wunderthausen. The ship docked in New York on November 11, 1867. She first lived near Tingley, Iowa, where she married Ludwig Homrighausen a few years later. What brought either of them to this area is not certain. She and her husband were second cousins, and both were third cousins to John Albert Riedesel (born the same year as both of them were) who was also living at Tingley at the time. All wound up near Idalia, Colorado.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen:

Born in Haasebergers house in Wunderthausen. Arrived in the port of New York on September 10, 1866, on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen. Settled near Tingley, Iowa, where he married Amalia in 1873. At least two of their children were born in Clinton County, Iowa (where Wheatland is). By 1900 the family had moved on to Arapahoe County, Colorado, in the Idalia precinct. Their descendants went by "Homrighaus."

- vi. Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on May 22, 1850 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 17, 1909 in Warren County, New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). She married Johannes Strackbein on March 10, 1872 in Wunderthausen. He was born on June 02, 1845 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 17, 1933 in New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).
  - vii. Johann Franz Homrighausen was born on April 11, 1855 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 12, 1925 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Müsse.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen: Born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen; lived in Lipses, from which his wife came.

iv. Maria Magdalena Homrighausen was born on February 26, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 01, 1856 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Strackbein on October 08, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He was born on October 25, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 30, 1899 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Strackbein: Born in Schäfers Haus, Wunderthausen. Became the tenant in Hutheschäfers.

- 6. **Johann Ludwig Riedesel**, son of Johann Ludwig Riedesel and Anna Catharina Ruppert, was born on February 21, 1762 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 25, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He married **Anna Elisabeth Knoche** on March 02, 1801 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Pott: Born in and became the tenant in Mannes Haus.

- iii. Johannes Riedesel was born on September 26, 1805 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 22, 1808 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Georg Gabriel Riedesel was born on January 01, 1808 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 06, 1828 in Wunderthausen.
- v. Elisabeth Gertraud Riedesel was born on April 02, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 15, 1826 in Wunderthausen.
- vi. Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel was born on January 27, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 25, 1897 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Ludwig Homrighausen on July 11, 1836 in Wunderthausen. He was born on March 22, 1804 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 03, 1878 in Wunderthausen.
  - vii. Anna Catherine Riedesel was born on April 22, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 11, 1909 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). She married Johann Georg Riedesel in 1837. He was born on November 13, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 31, 1894 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." In other sources it is listed as Radle.

She appears to have been known as Mary Catherine.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Born in Seimes/Weisßkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1834. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They went to America and settled at Oxford, New Jersey (now Hazen) in 1837; the name of their ship or exact travel dates are not known. Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant.

At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations. Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. A transcription of the New Jersey death record lists him as "J. George Riddle." That source gives his year of death as 1893. His grave marker says 1884. Other family trees say 1894 which I am accepting for now but any of the dates is possible.

viii. Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born on May 13, 1817 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 27, 1903 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Caroline Matilda Schaeffer about 1845 in probably New Jersey. She was born on August 16, 1824 in Germany. She died on October 27, 1867 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey. He married Catherine ?? about 1870. She was born in 1832 in Bavaria. She died before 1885 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel:

Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born May 13, 1817, in Wunderthausen in the house known as Wetzels. He was the eighth of nine recorded children of Johann Ludwig and Anna Elisabeth (Knoche) Riedesel.

An older sister, Catherine, came to live in Warren County, New Jersey in 1837. Ludwig's application for naturalization states that he arrived in 1841 and that is the year he received permission to emigrate. He married Caroline Schaeffer (probably Schäfer) around 1845. She was born August 16, 1824 in Germany. One source gives Wunderthausen as her place of birth but this is unlikely. No Schäfer daughter is recorded in the birth records at this time--and no Schäfer family even lived in the village. Nor were they married there.

Several of the Riedesels who settled in Warren County came to be known as Riddle or Radle. It's not that there weren't other Germans around who could pronounce (and spell) Riedesel correctly, but this seemed to be the rule. Ludwig (or Louis) farmed near what was called Oxford Furnace. Ludwig finally received his naturalization papers in 1854 as "Ludwig Readle" though his signature says "Riedesel." He is buried as "Ludwig Riddle."

They had at least seven children before Caroline died in 1867. Four of their children are buried with them. The family name of his second wife Catherine is not known to me. Some have identified her as another Riedesel/Riddle by birth but that is almost certainly in error. There were three children that we know of from the marriage with Catherine.

Notes for Caroline Matilda Schaeffer:

There are claims that she came from Wunderthausen but there is no sign of her in the quite-complete local church records. There was no Schaeffer/Schäfer/Scheffer families in the village at all. Another source names her father as "Christian Allen." The first name was rare in Wittgenstein while "Allen" did not exist there. Their

daughter Louisa's death certificate from 1912 gives her name as "Clara Scheffer." If accurate, that is probably just a family nickname.

Notes for Catherine ??:

This Catherine has often been mistaken for another Riedesel/Riddle--by me among others--specifically a Catherine Riddle born in 1839 to Wunderthausen immigrants. The 1880 Census, however, shows that this woman was born in Bavaria about 1832. She is listed with her husband and family in the 1880 Federal Census but is not listed in the 1885 New Jersey Census and you must assume she had died. The grave marker for Catherine Riddle in the Hazen cemetery (d. August 08, 1917) belongs to the Catherine Riddle born in 1839 who never married. There is a Find-a-Grave entry for the latter but I think the birth year of 1832 is in error.

Anna Elisabeth Riedesel was born on February 20, 1819 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 03, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Franz Homrighausen on April 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen. He was born on July 06, 1814 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 27, 1907 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen:

Known as Franz. Born in Räderhaase/Haasebergers Haus in Wunderthausen. He apparently served some time in the Prussian army as he was later a member of a German veterans association in nearby Lowden. Came to Crawford County, Ohio with the extended Riedesel family. They had arrived in New York out of Bremen on June 7, 1845. The family moved on to what became the Wheatland community by 1857. According to the 1911 memorial booklet celebrating the 50th anniversary of the founding of St. Paul's church in Wheatland, he had been a founder the of the previous congregation in 1857.

By the time of his death, he owned 536 acres of farmland at Wheatland (in Sections 27, 28 and 33 of the Spring Rock Township). He was clearly a prosperous farmer and a respected elder in the German community and church. Though his two wives had the same given names, they were not that closely related. His one child with his first wife died a few months after she did in 1843.

The three sons each took over part of his substantial farm.
