# **Descendants of Caroline Knebel**

#### Generation 1

1. CAROLINE¹ KNEBEL was born on November 25, 1834 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 08, 1898 in Chicago, Cook, Illinois (St. Marcus Cemetery, Red Bud). She met (1) UNKNOWN. She married (2) WILLIAM HENZE on August 27, 1858 in Monroe, Illinois, USA. He died on July 05, 1860. She married (3) JOHANN JOST RIEDESEL, son of Georg Gabriel Riedesel and Florentine Riedesel, on September 14, 1860 in Monroe County, Illinois. He was born on April 23, 1825 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 13, 1899 in Chicago, Cook, Illinois (St. Marcus Cemetery, Red Bud).

#### Notes for Caroline Knebel:

Born in Beckers Haus, Wunderthausen. She came with several others from Wunderthausen on the ship "Johannes Schmidt" out of Bremen, landing in New Orleans on June 1, 1857. The rest of them went to Iowa. Her first cousins once removed, the Homrighausen brothers from Linde Haus in Wunderthausen, had gone to the area in 1839. Caroline had a daughter, Katherine, in Wunderthausen in 1854. The daughter stayed there and died at 22.

Caroline and her first husband, William Henze, lived at Lords Corner near Hecker, Illinois.

She and Johannes Riedesel lived in both Monroe County (Hecker) and St. Clair County (Smithton), but are buried near Hecker.

Unknown and Caroline Knebel had the following child:

2. i. KATHARINE<sup>2</sup> KNEBEL was born on January 10, 1854 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 18, 1876 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for William Henze:

Shot and killed in an altercation by Henry Alter. The latter was convicted and hung on December 28, 1860 in Waterloo, IL.

William Henze and Caroline Knebel had the following child:

3. i. Henry² Henze was born on June 28, 1860. He died on May 31, 1933 in Monroe County, Illinois (St. Marcus Cemetery, Red Bud). He married Katharine Heyl.

## Notes for Johann Jost Riedesel:

Born in the house called Försters am Lotzenberg in Wundethausen. He was probably on the ship Johann Lange out of Bremen that landed in New York on September 23, 1857. He was already 35 when he married the widow Caroline (Knebel) Henze. They apparently lived in Monroe County, Prairie du Long township until at least 1880 (when they are recorded in the Census under the name "Ritt"). But by the late 1880s they are mentioned in the records of what is now St. John's United Church of Christ in Smithton, IL. Known as John or Johananes.

In 1870, he owned real estate worth \$4,500--a substantial sum. That Census lists a daughter "Mina" who was 5 years old; this corresponds to Katherine who was born in 1865. The same Census lists a 2-year old "Catherine", who should be Carolina according to family records. Living them was a 36-year old Henry "Knoebel" (Knebel), possibly Ludwig Heinrich Knebel (\*Nov 4, 1834 in Wunderthausen in Schwarze house). Or her brother "Henry" who was born in 1838.

Johann Jost Riedesel and Caroline Knebel had the following children:

- i. SOPHIA<sup>2</sup> RIEDESEL was born on October 15, 1863 in St Clair, Illinois. She died on March 21, 1891 in Smithton, St Clair, Illinois (St. Marcus Cemetery, Red Bud). She married John Henry Grommet on April 30, 1885 in Monroe County, Illinois. He was born on June 21, 1858. He died on April 04, 1921 in Marissa, St Clair, Illinois (Dutch Hill Cemetery).
- 5. ii. KATHERINE RIEDESEL was born on November 26, 1865 in Monroe County, Illinois. She died on June 16, 1946 in Belleville, St Clair, Illinois (Smithton-Franklin Cemetery). She married Edward Rieso, son of Gottlieb Frederick Rieso and Anna Katherine Maria Sophie Heidenreich, on May 17, 1887 in Floraville, Illinois. He was born on January 11, 1859 in St Clair, Illinois. He died on August 25, 1945 in St Clair, Illinois (Smithton-Franklin Cemetery).

Notes for Caroline Katherine Grommet: Known as Carrie.

ii. Henry Grommet was born about 1888. He died on July 16, 1893 in Smithton, St Clair, Illinois.

Notes for Henry Grommet:

Killed in accident when a wheat binder severed his legs while he was hunting rabbits.

iii. WILLIAM GROMMET was born on August 23, 1889 in Hecker, Monroe, Illinois. He died on June 09, 1968. He married CATHERINE ??. She was born on July 26, 1894. She died on April 10, 1969.

Notes for William Grommet:

Known as Willie. After his mother's death, he went to live with his Riedesel grandparents.

- iv. OSCAR GROMMET was born on March 20, 1891 in Smithton, St Clair, Illinois. He died on July 11, 1891 (Saint Marcus Cemetery-Red Bud).
- 5. **KATHERINE**<sup>2</sup> **RIEDESEL** (Caroline<sup>1</sup> Knebel) was born on November 26, 1865 in Monroe County, Illinois. She died on June 16, 1946 in Belleville, St Clair, Illinois (Smithton-Franklin Cemetery). She married Edward Rieso, son of Gottlieb Frederick Rieso and Anna Katherine Maria Sophie Heidenreich, on May 17, 1887 in Floraville, Illinois. He was born on January 11, 1859 in St Clair, Illinois. He died on August 25, 1945 in St Clair, Illinois (Smithton-Franklin Cemetery).
