Generation 1

 Johann Franz Knoche, son of Georg Ludwig Knoche and Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen, was born on July 01, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died in September 1920 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He married Maria Amalia Homrighausen on August 05, 1884 in Miami, Kansas. She was born on December 20, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1932 in Kaw, Jackson County, Missouri, United States of America. He married an unknown spouse on August 05, 1884.

Notes for Johann Franz Knoche:

Known as John in America. He was recorded as the out-of-wedlock child of his mother in Schäfers Haus in Wunderthausen with no notation as to who the father was. Three years later his mother went to America with some others from Wunderthausen and eventually married Georg Ludwig Knoche from that party. While he may or may not have been the father of the child, John took the name Knoche. By his own report, he came to America in 1867 long after his mother. As of 1900 they were living with their children on the farm of his parents (close the George W. Homrighausen farm).

Notes for Maria Amalia Homrighausen: Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America on the ship Köln out of Bremerhaven arriving in Baltimore April 10, 1881. Known as Amelia.

Generation 2

- 2. **Georg Ludwig Knoche**, son of Johannes Knoche and Elisabeth Magdalena Mörchen, was born on November 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died in April 1906 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He married **Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen** in 1870.
- 3. **Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen**, daughter of Johannes Homrighausen and Maria Katherine Strackbein, was born on May 16, 1828 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 05, 1918 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Known as Louis. Arrived in New Orleans on the ship "Auguste" out of Bremen on October 25, 1854.

According to a local history:

LOUIS KNOCHE, farmer, Section 7, P. O. Paola, was born in Prussia, Germany, in 1829; was a farmer by occupation. Emigrated to America in 1854; made his home at Kansas City, Mo., til 1861. He then came to Paola and purchased his present farm of 160 acres of the Indian chief Baptiste Peoria. Mr. Knoche has served six years as Treasurer of the School Board of his district. During the late war he was enrolled as a member of the State Militia and served as a guard to protect the State from invasion by the Confederates.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen:

Born in Schäfers Haus in Wunderthausen and had her child Johann Franz before emigrating. Her obituary in the Miami Republican wrongly states that she and her husband came directly to Paola from Germany in 1871. Arrived October 25, 1854 in New Orleans on the ship "Auguste" out of Bremen and lived in Missouri before moving to Paola in 1861. She bore no other children.

The obituary mentions a surviving sister "Mrs. Mary Catherine Switzgabel of Kansas City" whom I have not been able to identify

Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen and Georg Ludwig Knoche had the following child:

 Johann Franz Knoche was born on July 01, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He died in September 1920 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He married Maria Amalia Homrighausen on August 05, 1884 in Miami, Kansas. She was born on December 20, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1932 in Kaw, Jackson County, Missouri, United States of America. He married an unknown spouse on August 05, 1884.

- 4. **Johannes Knoche**, son of Ludwig Henrich Knoche and Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen, was born on December 27, 1792 in Wunderthausen. He died after 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married **Elisabeth Magdalena Mörchen** on January 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen.
- 5. **Elisabeth Magdalena Mörchen**, daughter of Georg Franz Mörchen and Maria Amalia Womelsdorf, was born on August 16, 1805 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 13, 1850 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Tenant in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Arrived in New Orleans on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen on Octtober 13, 1857 after being widowed.

Elisabeth Magdalena Mörchen and Johannes Knoche had the following children:

- i. Georg Ludwig Knoche was born on November 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died in April 1906 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He married Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen in 1870. She was born on May 16, 1828 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 05, 1918 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.
 - ii. Johann Heinrich Knoche was born on November 17, 1832 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Knoche: Born in the house 'Auf der Leye (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. He came with his older brother Georg Ludwig aboard the ship Auguste out of Bremen to New Orleans, arriving on October 20, 1854. I can find no further trace of him past the 1860 Census when he lived with the family of John P. Knoche.

- iii. Johann Ludwig Knoche was born on November 22, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 28, 1836 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche was born on August 28, 1837 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. She was apparently on board the Hermann with her father and younger siblings when it arrived in New Orleans on October 14, 1857. What happened to her subsequently, I do not know.

v. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche was born on November 23, 1840 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Elisabeth Amalia Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Presumably went to America with the family, arriving in New Orleans on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen on Octtober 13, 1857.

She may have been the Elizabeth Heinzelman mentioned in the 1906 obituary of her father. A widow by this name did live in San Francisco in 1900, though her birth date is listed as August 1843. This does not match any Wunderthausen birth records.

vi. Anna Elisabeth Knoche was born on April 30, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 08, 1909 in Jackson, Missouri. She married Ludwig Knoche on March 27, 1863. He was born on December 09, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 16, 1917 in Jackson, Missouri.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Arrived in New Orleans on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen on Octtober 13, 1857. Known as Katherine or Katie in the U.S. She bore 9 children but I have names only of these 8. Living in Martin City, Missouri, as of 1906.

Notes for Ludwig Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Naturalized in 1858.

"Louis KNOCHE, farmer, section 29, post-office Belton, is a native of Prussia, and was born December 9, 1834, and was there reared and educated. In the spring of

1854 he came to America, landing in New Orleans, and from there came to Jackson County, where he now owns ninety acres, with a good residence. He was married in this county, March 27, 1863, to Katie KNOCHE. They have six children: Katie, Henry, Louis, George, James and Omolaci." [sic]

Source: "The History of Jackson County, Missouri" published in 1881. There was a Ludwig Knoche of about the right age who landed in New Orlean on the ship Carl in 1859 but I doubt this was the same man.

vii. Johannes Knoche was born on March 19, 1846 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 15, 1920 in Miami County, Kansas. He married Catherine Homrighausen on March 03, 1879. She was born on December 12, 1853 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1939 in Miami County, Kansas.

Notes for Johannes Knoche:

Born in the house 'Auf der Leye' (later Kellers) in Wunderthausen. Arrived in New Orleans on the ship "Hermann" out of Bremen on October 13, 1857. Known as James. Came to America with his father. Lived first in Jackson County, Missouri, came to Paola, Kansas in 1861. In 1879 he bought farmland near the town of Valley.

Notes for Catherine Homrighausen:

Born in Bormanns house in Wunderthausen. She came to New York on the ship "Donau" on November 25, 1871. Was in the company of Wunderthausen emigrants.

- Johannes Homrighausen, son of Johannes Homrighausen and Maria Magdalena Homrighausen, was born on January 01, 1802 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 11, 1870 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Katherine Strackbein on November 25, 1825 in Wunderthausen.
- Maria Katherine Strackbein, daughter of Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein and Anna Catherina Elisabeth Riedesel, was born on February 05, 1801 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 07, 1873 in Wunderthausen.

Maria Katherine Strackbein and Johannes Homrighausen had the following children:

- Johann Ludwig Homrighausen was born on September 24, 1823 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 01, 1909 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Catherine Beitzel on July 06, 1851 in Wunderthausen. She was born on October 13, 1826 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 08, 1893 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. Catherine Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on November 12, 1826 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 09, 1881 in Wunderthausen. She met Johann Georg Wetter. He was born on September 17, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 03, 1898 in Glidden, Carroll, Iowa. She married Johann Georg Riedesel on September 21, 1851 in Wunderthausen. He was born on March 20, 1822 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 30, 1886 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Catherine Elisabeth Homrighausen: Born in Schäfers house. She gave birth a few months after the child's father had left for America. The paternity was not in question.

Notes for Johann Georg Wetter:

Known as George, or John George. Born at Petersgrund near Wunderthausen, first came to the U. S. with his parents briefly in 1833 before returning to Wunderthausen. In 1845, the family came back to the U.S. We used to think they debarked in New Orleans but we now have record of them traveling on the ship Minna which landed in New York on October 4, 1845. According to Emma Wetter Hobbs, they settled near Sherrill, Iowa around 1847 (long known as Sherills

Mound). This is where George and Sophia met and most of the large Wetter family remained. George had 80 acres of timberland at Sherrill.

George and his family moved to a farm in Sections 29 and 32 of the Liberty Township of Clinton County in 1861. As far as I know, no other Wetter family members came to the Wheatland area.

In November 1875 the land was sold to David and John Shoemaker, nephews of the second wife of L. Henry Riedesel (viz. Elisabeth Schumacher). George, Sophia and their children moved on to Glidden, Iowa in 1876 and spent the rest of their days there.

His daughter by Catherine Homrighausen back in Wunderthausen lived to be an adult, and came to America as well. What, if any, contact there was between them or knowledge within the Wheatland diaspora there was, we just don't know.

- iii. Elisabeth Amalia Homrighausen was born on May 16, 1828 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 05, 1918 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. She married Georg Ludwig Knoche in 1870. He was born on November 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died in April 1906 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.
 - iv. Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on April 16, 1830 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Elisabeth Homrighausen:

May have come to America, possibly as a passenger on the ship "Main" that arrived in New York on May 13, 1871. Other Wunderthäuser were on board. She most closely matches the woman on the passenger list, and no death date is recorded for Elisabeth in Wunderthausen. Three siblings went to America.

v. Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on April 29, 1833 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 30, 1910 in Willcox, Cochise, Arizona. He married Anna Knoche in 1860. She died in 1864 in Paola, Miami, Kansas. He married Elizabeth Barger on January 04, 1866 in Independence, Clay, Missouri. She was born on October 25, 1846 in Santa Fe, Monroe, Missouri. She died on December 08, 1919 in Paola, Miami, Kansas.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen:

Born in Schäfers Haus in Wunderthausen. Known as Georg Wilhelm or George William. Arrived October 25, 1854 in New Orleans on the ship "Auguste" out of Bremen. Went to Kansas City where he was a stone mason. Moved to Paola, Kansas, in 1861 where he farmed. Lived in Arizona the last two years or so of his life. He claimed to have been naturalized in about 1855. I have been unable to find him in any Census prior to 1880.

Notes for Anna Knoche:

It is unclear who she was. Contrary to some reports, she cannot have been the Anna Elisabeth born April 30, 1843.

vi. Johann Franz Homrighausen was born on July 05, 1836 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 12, 1909 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Elisabeth Strackbein on July 16, 1865 in Wunderthausen. She was born on June 17, 1839 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 11, 1880 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen: Lived in Schäfers.

vii. Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen was born on January 11, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 15, 1926 in Miami County, Kansas. She married Johann Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein in 1864. He was born on October 13, 1838 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 30, 1918 in Miami County, Kansas.

Notes for Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen: Born in Schäfers house in Wunderthausen. Listed as "Marie" Strackbein when they landed in New York on the ship "Hansa" out of Bremen on May 22, 1865.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein: Born in Hutheschäfers house in Wunderthausen. Arrived with his wife in the port of New York on the ship "Hansa" out of Bremen on May 22, 1865. Known as Henry. Lived around Wheatland initially but moved on to Miami County, Kansas.

Generation 4

- 8. Ludwig Henrich Knoche, son of Johann Henrich Knoche and Anna Elisabeth Spies, was born on March 23, 1764 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 08, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen on November 30, 1791 in Wunderthausen.
- 9. **Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen**, daughter of Georg Franz Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Riedesel, was born on March 18, 1771 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 04, 1846 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Henrich Knoche:

Born in Schmeds Haus but became the tenant in Kellers, Wunderthausen. It is quite possible that the three other sons also came to America.

Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen and Ludwig Henrich Knoche had the following children:

- Johannes Knoche was born on December 27, 1792 in Wunderthausen. He died after 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married Elisabeth Magdalena Mörchen on January 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen. She was born on August 16, 1805 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 13, 1850 in Wunderthausen.
 - ii. Elisabeth Gertraud Knoche was born on May 28, 1796 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 22, 1862 in Wunderthausen. She married Daniel Müsse.

Notes for Elisabeth Gertraud Knoche: Born and lived in Kellers house.

- iii. Georg Franz Knoche was born on March 04, 1799 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Johannes Heinrich Knoche was born on January 17, 1802 in Wunderthausen.
- v. Anna Elisabeth Knoche was born on April 21, 1804 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 14, 1870 in Wunderthausen. She married Johannes Knoche on January 18, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He was born on September 18, 1794 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 23, 1849 in Wunderthausen.
- vi. Elisabeth Amalia Knoche was born on November 08, 1807 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 26, 1851 in Wunderthausen. She married Georg Gabriel Riedesel on August 24, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He was born on September 20, 1809 in Wunderthausen. He died before 1880 in Clay County, Kansas.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Riedesel:

Known as Ludwig. Born in the house "Ludwigs unter der Leye" but established the house in Wunderthausen known as Schreiners/Großeludwigs. His two wives had the same birth names, but the first was apparently known as Maria and the second as Amalia. Ludwig came to America with his second wife and at least three children on the ship Argonaut out of Bremen. It arrived at New York on November 9, 1867. We have newspaper advertisements that he placed in Wittgenstein in the summer of 1867 putting the house, property and harvest up for sale. He owned less than three acres of cropland and a couple pieces of pasture land.

The obituary of his son, Louis D. (from his first marriage), alludes to two halfsisters. One was Catherine and the other was probably the girl identified as "Dina" on the ship's manifest. The latter was--I believe--a common nickname for "Christine." Yet I find no record of her in the Wunderthausen records.

A recent history from Wunderthausen lists a death date in May 1884. However, I

find no trace of Ludwig in the 1880 Census but his supposedly widowed wife is living with their son, Phillip.

 vii. Johann Georg Knoche was born on June 05, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died after 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married Maria Amalia Knoche about 1841. She was born on February 01, 1810 in Wunderthausen. She died before 1860 in Jackson, Missouri. He married an unknown spouse about 1858.

Notes for Johann Georg Knoche:

Born in Wunderthausen in "Auf der Leye" (later Kellers) Haus. He went to America around 1834. He lived in Jackson County, Missouri. He was a landowner of some means. He must have visited Germany then returned to America in 1841, as it almost certainly him on the ship Diana that year.

Notes for Maria Amalia Knoche:

Born in Beitzels house. The marriage with Johannes Knoche ended in divorce. Came to the US with family members and her to-be husband, Johann Georg Knoche on the ship Diana out of Bremen which landed in New Orleans on June 2, 1841. She is listed in the 1850 Census as 'Mary' but by 1860 she was dead.

- viii. Anna Catherine Knoche was born on February 14, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 18, 1817 in Wunderthausen.
- 10. **Georg Franz Mörchen**, son of Johann Jost Mörchen and Elisabeth Gertraud Homrighausen, was born on July 15, 1769 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 30, 1847 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Amalia Womelsdorf** on January 17, 1802 in Wunderthausen.
- 11. **Maria Amalia Womelsdorf**, daughter of Ludwig Heinrich Womelsdorf and Maria Amalia Wagner, was born on April 22, 1770 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 21, 1829 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Franz Mörchen:

Born at the Wunderthausen mill. Married the widow of the tenant at Seilers Haus.

Maria Amalia Womelsdorf and Georg Franz Mörchen had the following children:

- i. Georg Ludwig Mörchen was born on October 20, 1802 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 14, 1847 in Wunderthausen.

- 13. **Maria Magdalena Homrighausen**, daughter of Georg Gabriel Homrighausen and Anna Elisabeth Gertraudt Dienst, was born on March 05, 1777 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 25, 1847 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Homrighausen:

Born in Hohmanns Haus, Wunderthausen. Became tenant in Brückeschneiders, Wunderthausen.

Maria Magdalena Homrighausen and Johannes Homrighausen had the following children:

- i. Johannes Homrighausen was born on January 01, 1802 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 11, 1870 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Katherine Strackbein on November 25, 1825 in Wunderthausen. She was born on February 05, 1801 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 07, 1873 in Wunderthausen.
 - Johann Ludwig Homrighausen was born on March 22, 1804 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 03, 1878 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Strackbein on November 25, 1825 in Wunderthausen. She was born on August 26, 1803 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 05, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Amalia Riedesel on July 11, 1836 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 27, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on October 25, 1897 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Homrighausen:

He was born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen. He inherited it from his father, but it may have had little if any agricultural land. In his early youth he was employed as a shepherd in neighboring Diedenshausen and then as teacher in the small settlements at Dachsloch and Langewiese. However, in 1833 he began what would be a lifetime of employment as one of the school teachers in Diedenshausen. His family continued to live in Wunderthausen (2km away), but during school he was only there two nights a week.

Originally, his compensation was mostly in grain though he was later paid a cash salary. It was meagre, and like most men in the region he pursued a side craft to help make ends meet. Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier

iii. Johann Georg Homrighausen was born on June 20, 1807 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 15, 1885 in Wunderthausen. He married Christiana Elisabeth Ruppert on July 08, 1832 in Wunderthausen. She was born on May 10, 1807 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 21, 1847 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen: Born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen; lived in Lipses, from which his wife came.

iv. Maria Magdalena Homrighausen was born on February 26, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 01, 1856 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Strackbein on October 08, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He was born on October 25, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 30, 1899 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Strackbein: Born in Schäfers Haus, Wunderthausen. Became the tenant in Hutheschäfers.

- Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein, son of Johann Georg Strackbein and Maria Magdalena Pott, was born on August 26, 1771 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 06, 1826 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Catherina Elisabeth Riedesel on July 23, 1796 in Wunderthausen.
- 15. **Anna Catherina Elisabeth Riedesel**, daughter of Georg Gabriel Riedesel and Elisabeth Gertraud Weller, was born on February 15, 1773 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 24, 1847 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein:

Born in Kurts Haus, Wunderthausen. Became the tenant in Schäfers.

Anna Catherina Elisabeth Riedesel and Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein had the following children:

Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier
