He married Katharina Elisabeth Dickel, daughter of Christian Wilhelm Dickel and Anna Elisabeth Sonneborn, on May 27, 1862 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 28, 1838 in Röspe. She died on June 13, 1885 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel:

Born in Altehäusers Haus in Wunderthausen. Arrived with his son Christian Willi in New York on September 14, 1893 on the ship "Lahn" out of Bremen. Known as Henry. Lived in Rochester, New York.

Ludwig Heinrich Riedesel and Katharina Elisabeth Dickel had the following children:

- EDUARD² RIEDESEL was born on October 01, 1860 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1945 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Florentine Frank on February 01, 1886 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. AUGUST RIEDESEL was born on July 06, 1862 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 21, 1919 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Leng on September 05, 1891 in Wunderthausen. She was born on September 20, 1868 in Hatzfeld. She died on October 06, 1950 in Wunderthausen.
- iii. Luise Riedesel was born on June 23, 1864 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 07, 1865 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. CHRISTIAN WILLI RIEDESEL was born on May 22, 1872 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 20, 1965 in Rochester, Monroe, New York. He married Anna Duerr, daughter of George Duerr and Barbara Reichert, on May 05, 1909 in Rochester, Monroe, New York (Salem Evangelical Church-Rochester). She was born on June 03, 1882 in Sussen, Wurtemberg, Germany. She died in April 1978 in Rochester, Monroe, New York.

Notes for Christian Willi Riedesel:

The Social Security Index lists his date of birth as May 18, but the church record in Wunderthausen says May 22 (that is not a baptismal date). Arrived at Ellis Island with his father on September 14, 1893. They were on the ship "Lahn" out of Bremen. In 1940 he is listed as having only three years of education. Although Willi is usually a nickname for Wilhelm, the church record in Wunderthausen calls him "Chr. Willi" so I take that as his given name. However, his grave marker says Wilhelm.

Notes for Anna Duerr:

Social Security Index gives her date of death as April, but another source says March.
