Generation 1

1. **Florentine Christine Schmidt**, daughter of Georg Henrich Schmidt and Elisabeth Gertraud Delcourt, was born on January 11, 1809 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 25, 1884 in Wentworth, Lake, South Dakota. She married **Conrad Limmer**. He was born on October 13, 1805 in Bavaria. He died on June 01, 1874 in Howards Grove, Sheboygan, Wisconsin.

Notes for Florentine Christine Schmidt:

Born in Schmidts/Lieses Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America on the ship Louise, docking in Baltimore on June 3, 1841. There are no other Wittgensteiners that I can recognize among the 300+ passengers. She was without question coming to join her brother who had arrived a few years before. For luggage she had "one little box."

Generation 2

2. **Georg Henrich Schmidt** was born on December 12, 1762 in Birkefehl. He died on April 13, 1826 in Wunderthausen. He married **Elisabeth Gertraud Delcourt**.
3. **Elisabeth Gertraud Delcourt** was born on March 17, 1770 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 02, 1845 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Henrich Schmidt:

First resident in Lieses/Schmidthaus; school teacher.

Elisabeth Gertraud Delcourt and Georg Henrich Schmidt had the following children:

- i. **Johann Henrich Schmidt** was born on March 30, 1806 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 31, 1873 in Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He married Catherine Elisabeth Wetter on November 10, 1833. She was born on January 31, 1801 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 08, 1876 in Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Notes for Johann Henrich Schmidt:

Born in Schmidts/Lieses Haus in Wunderthausen. They arrived in the port of Baltimore on July 1, 1834 on the ship Palmer out of Bremen. There had been Wetter kin in Baltimore where they first lived, and there were to be later connections around Massilon, Ohio where they also lived. They settled for good in Milwaukee in 1844.

Notes for Catherine Elisabeth Wetter:

Born at Petersgrund near Wunderthausen and came to America with her husband and one child on the ship "Palmer" that arrived in Baltimore in July 1834. It is a good guess that the child was her son, Georg Gabriel, who was born out of wedlock. Whether Schmidt was the father is not recorded. They wound up in Milwaukee.
