

Ancestors of Anna Katharine Schneider

Generation 1

1. **Anna Katharine Schneider**, daughter of Johann Franz Schneider and Anna Catherine Pott, was born on June 17, 1853 in Wunderhausen. She died on March 19, 1876 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She married **Georg Ludwig Fuchs** on September 02, 1872 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He was born on January 18, 1828 in Wunderhausen. He died on February 16, 1904 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Anna Katharine Schneider:

Born in Wunderhausen in the house known as Hanphilippes. Arrived in New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen on July 19, 1854.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Fuchs:

Known as Louis Fox. Born in Lotzes Haus in Wunderhausen. Arrived in New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen on July 19, 1854, three years after his older brother. Lived first in New Jersey for about two years and then went on to California by sailing around South America to dig for gold. They worked there for 15 years, and finally settled near Wheatland in 1871 where they bought 300 acres of farmland. Most was in Section 19 of the Spring Rock township of Clinton County.

Generation 2

2. **Johann Franz Schneider**, son of Johann Philipp Schneider and Maria Amalia Riedesel, was born on October 27, 1829 in Wunderhausen. He died on July 10, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married **Anna Catherine Pott** on August 03, 1854 in America.
3. **Anna Catherine Pott**, daughter of Johannes Pott and Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel, was born on February 13, 1831 in Wunderhausen. She died on July 18, 1910 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa.

Notes for Johann Franz Schneider:

Known as Franz. Born in the Wunderhausen house called Hanphilippes. Came to New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen and arrived on July 19, 1854. The passenger list gives Anna's name as Schneider and lists baby Anna. Perhaps they married in Germany and had another ceremony in the U.S. Perhaps not. He was a deacon in the first Kirchenrat (Board) of St. Paul's church in 1861 as was one of his brothers (uncertain which). As late as July of 1860 (Census), he was living in Warren County, NJ, next to the Pott brothers. He owned farmland in Sections 15, 22 and 23 of the Spring Rock Township.

Notes for Anna Catherine Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderhausen. Arrived in New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen on July 19, 1854. Though they were not married until a month after landing, the passenger list (but not the German permission files) gives her last name as Schenider. Her name was on the family farm near Wheatland as of 1894; another large tract in Section 20 is also listed as belonging to "Mrs. F. Schneider." That may have been her but maybe not.

Anna Catherine Pott and Johann Franz Schneider had the following children:

 - i. Anna Katharine Schneider was born on June 17, 1853 in Wunderhausen. She died on March 19, 1876 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She married Georg Ludwig Fuchs on September 02, 1872 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He was born on January 18, 1828 in Wunderhausen. He died on February 16, 1904 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).
 - ii. Louisa Schneider was born on August 07, 1855 in New Jersey. She died on September 02, 1945 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Johann Heinrich Schneider on December 01, 1881 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He was born on August 13, 1848 in Wunderhausen. He died on July 31, 1937 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Louisa Schneider:

Her parents were emigrants from Wunderhausen. While also named Schneider,

she was "only" a second cousin.

Notes for Johann Heinrich Schneider:

Known as Henry W. Born in Häusches Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to America with his family on the ship "Johann Schmidt" on June 1, 1857 out of Bremen, landing in New Orleans. He had a farm in Section 27 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County.

- iii. Frank William Schneider was born on November 30, 1857 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey. He died on August 25, 1922 in Bellevue, King, Washington. He married Emma Susan Ristine on November 29, 1881 in Clinton County, Iowa. She was born on January 05, 1858 in Calamus, Clinton, Iowa. She died on January 19, 1905 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).
- iv. John Schneider was born on November 06, 1859 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey. He died on December 14, 1929 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Ernestine Amalia Beckmann on February 14, 1901 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She was born on December 22, 1877 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She died on April 05, 1945 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Julia Brumm on March 18, 1891 in Clinton Co., Iowa. She was born on August 27, 1867 in Scott County, Iowa. She died on July 30, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for John Schneider:

Though born in New Jersey, he came with his family to the Wheatland area in the mid-1860s.

- v. Albert Schneider was born on March 01, 1863 in Iowa City, Johnson, Iowa. He died on August 07, 1890 in Friend, Colorado (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Anna Marie Robley on February 24, 1887 in Rock Island, Illinois. She was born in 1866 in Calamus, Clinton, Iowa. She died in 1941 in Canton, Lincoln, South Dakota.

Notes for Albert Schneider:

George Knoche of Wheatland wrote in 1891 that Albert was "brought home" from the west last summer and died of nerve-fever.

- vi. Mary Anna Schneider was born on April 16, 1865 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She died on May 16, 1949 in Clarence, Cedar, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Georg Ludwig Knoche on October 10, 1889 in Clinton, Iowa. He was born on July 12, 1850 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 09, 1915 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Known as Louis. Born in Brückeweymers Haus in Wunderthausen. Arrived in the port of New York on May 13, 1871, aboard the "Main" out of Bremen. His sister Catherine was also a passenger. His brother wrote in 1889 that Louis had gone to homestead in Nebraska in about 1886. They were (back) farming near Wheatland in 1910, where Louis died five years later. I am reasonably sure that their land was in the southeast corner of Section 21 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County.

- vii. Theodore George Schneider was born on June 14, 1869 in Iowa. He died on February 27, 1955 in Wheatland, Clinton County, Iowa.

Notes for Theodore George Schneider:

Apparently never married. As of 1920 he was living with the family of his brother John.

- viii. Louis G. Schneider was born on September 01, 1871 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He died on July 20, 1905 in Spring Rock, Clinton, Iowa. He married Lena Schneider on December 30, 1896 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She was born on

March 24, 1872 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She died on May 09, 1967 in Calamus, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Generation 3

4. **Johann Philipp Schneider**, son of Johann Jost Schneider and Catharina Elisabeth Dorothea Riedesel, was born on September 21, 1788 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 22, 1838 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Amalia Riedesel** on May 05, 1811 in Wunderthausen.
5. **Maria Amalia Riedesel**, daughter of Johannes Riedesel and Maria Elisabeth Dienst, was born on January 18, 1789 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 19, 1846 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Philipp Schneider:

First tenant in Hanphilippes Haus in Wunderthausen.

Maria Amalia Riedesel and Johann Philipp Schneider had the following children:

- i. Elisabeth Schneider was born on November 03, 1809 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 28, 1841 in Wunderthausen.
- ii. Maria Magdalena Schneider was born on August 30, 1812 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 30, 1845 in Wunderthausen. She married Georg Ludwig Knoche. He was born on October 10, 1809 in Wunderthausen. He died in Probably in America. She married Hermann Schmidt on April 18, 1841 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Knoche:

Born in Bormanns Haus in Wunderthausen. He traveled with some relatives to the port of New Orleans on the ship Diana in 1841. It is most likely that he joined relatives in the Kansas City area but I have no other information. Daughter Elisabeth used the family name of Knoche even though the parents were not married.

- iii. Johannes Schneider was born on June 06, 1815 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 18, 1868 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Mörchen on October 10, 1841 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 31, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 14, 1890 in Wunderthausen.
- iv. Johann Georg Schneider was born on October 06, 1817 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 09, 1890 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Elisabeth Florentine Mörchen on August 15, 1847 in Wunderthausen. She was born on April 10, 1824 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 24, 1905 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Johann Georg Schneider:

Born in Hanphilippes Haus in Wunderthausen, and may have lived with his wife at "Am Gefälle." Applied to emigrate on March 23, 1857. Came to the US on the ship "Johann Schmidt" out of Bremen, landing in New Orleans on June 1, 1857. I believe they had a small farm on the eastern edge of Cedar County/Springfield Township/Section 13, and that he was called George D. I have been unable to locate the family in the 1860 Census in either the Spring Rock (Wheatland) Township of Clinton County, Iowa or in Cedar County. There were family connections back in New Jersey but I cannot imagine them sailing through New Orleans if that was their intent. It was a direct boat trip up to Clinton County. The fates of three of their children who were not enumerated in 1870 is thus unknown.

Notes for Elisabeth Florentine Mörchen:

Born in the Haus Am Gefälle in Wunderthausen. Came to the US on the ship "Johann Schmidt" out of Bremen, landing in New Orleans on June 1, 1857. By the 1900 Census she claimed 11 children, only 3 of whom were living--all with her.

- v. Florentine Schneider was born on November 16, 1819 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 24, 1894 in Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Johann Georg Fey on April 06, 1863 in Wunderthausen. He was born on June 29, 1809 in Münchhausen. He died on November 10, 1866 in Wunderthausen. She

married Carl Wilhelm Ebert after 1869. He was born on May 24, 1823 in Schwerin, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Germany. He died on July 06, 1907 in Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Florentine Schneider:

Born in Hanphilippes Haus in Wunderthausen where she continued to live during many years of a relationship with Heinrich Fey. They eventually married but he lived only a few more years. The Fey name was otherwise unknown in Wunderthausen. It is found primarily in the state of Hesse around Marburg. At the time of her husband's death, they were more or less boarding at a farm outside of Wunderthausen.

Florentine came to America on the ship "Marco Polo" out of Bremen, arriving in New York on June 1, 1868 with four children. She was by then a widow of a man with no property. It is a good hypothesis that the cost of her passage and that of the children was covered by relatives in America. Three had children died soon after birth. I do not know when Florentine and other children first came to Wheatland. As of the 1870 Census, only son George was in the area, working on the farm of Johann Franz Homrighausen. The youngest son, Philipp, seems to have stayed on the East Coast so I suspect that Florence and others lived there for a while (there being various relatives there).

By 1880 she was in Wheatland to marry Carl Ebert and they were farming in Cedar County, Iowa.

Notes for Johann Georg Fey:

Some records refer to him--at least I believe it is the same man--as Henrich/Henry. "Georg Henrich" would have been a common-enough full name. Although born in Münchhausen (south and east of Wittgenstein), he lived and worked as a hired hand at the Dambach farm near Girkhausen. Other records floating around erroneously give 1843 as the date of their marriage. They maintained a relationship for at least 20 years before marrying.

- vi. Johann Philipp Schneider was born on July 14, 1822 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 03, 1873 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel on January 23, 1848 in Wunderthausen. She was born on August 07, 1819 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 02, 1880 in Wunderthausen (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Johann Philipp Schneider:

First tenant in Mines hinter der Huthe in Wundethausen.

- vii. Johann Ludwig Schneider was born on October 15, 1824 in Wunderthausen.
- viii. Ludwig Heinrich Schneider was born on December 02, 1826 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 18, 1879 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Florentine Beitzel on November 13, 1853 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 10, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 05, 1911 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Schneider:

Known as Henry A. or L.H.A. Schneider around Wheatland. Born in Hanphilippes Haus in Wunderthausen. Applied to emigrate on March 6, 1857. Came to America on the ship "Johann Schmidt" from Bremen, arriving in New Orleans on June 1, 1857. He had a large farm in Section 20 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County. After his death, I believe that their son Phillip took over part of it.

Notes for Florentine Beitzel:

Born in the house "Hinter der Huthe" in Wunderthausen. Came with many others on the ship "Johann Schmidt" to New Orleans out of Bremen, arriving June 1, 1857. She had a total of ten children, but only four were alive as of 1900. Much of the farm was in her name as of 1894.

2. ix. Johann Franz Schneider was born on October 27, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 10, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). He married Anna Catherine Pott on August 03, 1854 in America. She was born on February 13, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 18, 1910 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa.
6. **Johannes Pott**, son of Johannes Pott and Maria Elisabeth Klein, was born on April 01, 1789 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 22, 1856 in Wunderthausen. He married **Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel** on August 03, 1823 in Wunderthausen.
7. **Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel**, daughter of Johann Ludwig Riedesel and Anna Elisabeth Knoche, was born on March 23, 1803 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 08, 1878 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Pott:

Born in and became the tenant in Mannes Haus.

Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel and Johannes Pott had the following children:

- i. Anna Elisabeth Pott was born on November 27, 1822 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 28, 1872 in Wunderthausen. She married Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein on July 28, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He was born on November 18, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 12, 1869 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein:

Born in and became the tenant in Kurts Haus.

- ii. Catherine Elisabeth Pott was born on January 09, 1825 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 18, 1902 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Lauber on July 04, 1847 in Wunderthausen. He was born on November 24, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 12, 1912 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Catherine Elisabeth Pott:

Born in Mannes house.

Notes for Johann Georg Lauber:

Founded the house "Im Gründchen" outside of Wunderthausen though was born in Hohmanns.

- iii. Johannes Pott was born on January 08, 1827 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 10, 1913 in Hazen, Warren, New Jersey (Hillside Cemetery, Oxford). He married Christiana Hirt about 1860. She was born in 1841 in Berne, Switzerland. She died in 1906 (Hillside Cemetery, Oxford).

Notes for Johannes Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. He arrived in New York on the ship Centurion out of Antwerp in 1852. Living in the Oxford, NJ, area in the late 1890s. He is described as having been a big man in family records. Living with his brother, George, at the time of the 1860 Census and was apparently single then; occupation was that of a miner. He eventually became known as "Potts" as did his sons.

- iv. Elisabeth Amalia Pott was born on November 25, 1828 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 09, 1901 in Wunderthausen. She married Johannes Strackbein on June 12, 1853 in Wunderthausen. He was born on August 17, 1824 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 12, 1863 in Wunderthausen.
3. v. Anna Catherine Pott was born on February 13, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 18, 1910 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She married Johann Franz Schneider on August 03, 1854 in America. He was born on October 27, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 10, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

-
- vi. Johann Georg Pott was born on July 13, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 10, 1913 in Hazen, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Mary Johanna Glashner on April 18, 1872. She was born about 1840 in Weimar. She died in 1922 (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Elisabeth Leinbach on April 16, 1858. She was born on July 28, 1835 in Prussia. She died on March 10, 1872 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey.

Notes for Johann Georg Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus, Wunderthausen. German records confirm that he came to America on the ship Rio Packet out of Bremen, landing in New York on July 19, 1854. That record says he was bound for Kentucky and had a child (unnamed) with him.

Lived in Warren County, NJ. Known as George. Naturalized in September, 1859. His death certificate says that he died of apoplexy.

Notes for Mary Johanna Glashner:

Her name may have been Glasner.

Notes for Elisabeth Leinbach:

Records of the Jonestown Hillside Cemetery, Warren Co NJ list an "Eliza Potts", wife of George, who was born July 28, 1828, and died March 18, 1872. This could be the same woman but the details differ.

- vii. Wilhelmine Pott was born on October 07, 1836 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Heinrich Althaus on November 23, 1866 in Elsoff. He was born on February 16, 1839 in Beddelhausen.

Notes for Wilhelmine Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. She was supposed to have gone to America but that is incorrect.

- viii. Georg Ludwig Pott was born on February 02, 1839 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 01, 1839 in Wunderthausen.
- ix. Luise Florentine Pott was born on August 21, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 05, 1900 in Wunderthausen.
- x. Elisabeth Pott was born on May 14, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 03, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Georg Heinrich Dickel on February 11, 1872 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He was born on December 02, 1830 in Girkhausen. He died on March 05, 1917 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Elisabeth Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus, Wundethausen. Came to the U.S. on the ship Deutschland, landing in New York on October 10, 1868.

Notes for Georg Heinrich Dickel:

Known as Henry. Born in the house called Zwistmühle, a single Hof between Neuastenberg and Girkhausen. At the time of his birth, the mill belonged to the parish and community of Girkhausen. Only following a modern reorganization is the property officially tied to the village of Neuastenberg in the town of Winterberg in the Hochsauerland Kreis.

Came to America on the ship "Jupiter" out of Bremen, landing in New York on June 11, 1867. With his brother he owned 80 acres in Section 5 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County. His older son, Carl/Charles, eventually took over the farm.

8. **Johann Jost Schneider**, son of Johannes Schneider and Anna Maria Helm, was born on October 31, 1756 in Helberhausen. He died on February 26, 1839 in Wunderthausen. He married **Catharina Elisabeth Dorothea Riedesel** on February 14, 1783 in Wunderthausen.
 9. **Catharina Elisabeth Dorothea Riedesel**, daughter of Gabriel Riedesel and Anna Margarete Kümmer, was born on August 30, 1766 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 02, 1806 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Jost Schneider:

Born in the Hilchenbach area but married into Altehäusers Haus in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Catharina Elisabeth Dorothea Riedesel:

Born in Altehäusers Haus, the tenancy of which passed to her husband. Known as Anna Elisabeth.

Catharina Elisabeth Dorothea Riedesel and Johann Jost Schneider had the following children:

- i. Georg Ludwig Schneider was born on December 28, 1783 in Wunderthausen. He died on September 08, 1837 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Gertraud Riedesel on December 11, 1800 in Wunderthausen. She was born on March 02, 1781 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 14, 1852 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Schneider:

Born in Altehäusers Haus and became the tenant after his father.

Notes for Elisabeth Gertraud Riedesel:

Born in Weymers Haus in Wunderthausen.

 - ii. Johann Philipp Schneider was born on September 21, 1788 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 22, 1838 in Wunderthausen. He married Maria Amalia Riedesel on May 05, 1811 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 18, 1789 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 19, 1846 in Wunderthausen.
 - iii. Johann Georg Schneider was born on January 21, 1791 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 17, 1791 in Wunderthausen.
 - iv. Maria Elisabeth Schneider was born on May 08, 1792 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 24, 1799 in Wunderthausen.
 - v. Johann Franz Schneider was born on January 06, 1794 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 15, 1796 in Wunderthausen.
10. **Johannes Riedesel**, son of Georg Gabriel Riedesel and Elisabeth Gertraud Weller, was born on August 27, 1753 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 19, 1835 in Wunderthausen. He married **Maria Elisabeth Dienst** on April 21, 1776 in Wunderthausen.
11. **Maria Elisabeth Dienst**, daughter of Johannes Dienst and Maria Magdalena Pott, was born on February 26, 1755 in Wunderthausen. She died on February 07, 1805 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Riedesel:

Born into Weymers Haus and became the tenant. He was the second person to serve as schoolmaster in Wunderthausen. There was no school building so classes were held in one or another house, which was not very satisfactory.

Notes for Maria Elisabeth Dienst:

Born in Linde Haus in Wunderthausen.

Maria Elisabeth Dienst and Johannes Riedesel had the following children:

- i. Johann Franz Riedesel was born on August 21, 1774 in Wunderthausen. He died on November 14, 1843 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Margarete Fuchs on December 11, 1800 in Wunderthausen. She was born on January 11, 1777 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Franz Riedesel:

Born in Weymers Haus but became the tenant in Seimes.

- ii. Maria Juliana Riedesel was born on March 31, 1777 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 04, 1777 in Wunderthausen.

- iii. Johann Georg Riedesel was born on June 02, 1778 in Wunderthausen. He died on April 15, 1857 in Wunderthausen. He married Catherine Elisabeth Fuchs on December 11, 1800 in Wunderthausen. She was born on December 22, 1778 in Wunderthausen. She died on November 22, 1845 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Born in and tenant in Weymers Haus, Wunderthausen.

- v. Ludwig Riedesel was born on February 21, 1784 in Wunderthausen. He died in 1847 in Galion, Crawford, Ohio. He married Florentine Althaus on February 08, 1818 in Wunderthausen. She was born on April 08, 1792 in Wunderthausen. She died in 1847 in Galion, Crawford, Ohio.

Notes for Ludwig Riedesel:

He was born in Weymers Haus in Wunderthausen but married into Haase Haus. This was one of the smaller houses in the village. It was unusual for a man his age to emigrate, but the greater opportunities for his four sons (and already married daughter) may have been compelling. The house and property (meagre, I think) were sold to J. Daniel Müsse from Jochums Haus. Most of the family traveled to New York, landing on June 7, 1845. Son J. Ludwig had gone the year before, and they brought with them his fiance, Catherine Schneider. All settled in Crawford County, Ohio.

Ludwig and Florentine died around 1847-1848, reportedly in an epidemic of some kind (cholera?) along with their daughter-in-law and at least one grandchild. They were interred in a private cemetery probably belonging to the Gerhardts. Its identity is long lost but we are reasonably certain where it is.

Notes for Florentine Althaus:

She was born in Haase Haus, which passed to her husband upon their marriage since she was the oldest child. In 1845, most of the family left Wunderthausen to go to America. They traveled on the ship "New York" out of Bremen, and landed in New York city on June 7, 1845. Her sister, Maria Elisabeth, had come to America years before, married Christian Gerhardt, and settled in Crawford County, Ohio. They joined them. Florentine and her husband died within a few years, reportedly in 1847-1848 in an epidemic.

- vi. Johannes Riedesel was born on June 24, 1787 in Wunderthausen. He died on January 16, 1812 in Stetti.

Notes for Johannes Riedesel:

He died in a military hospital in Stettin, a once German city now "Szczecin" in Poland. He was a conscript in the army with which Napoleon fatally invaded Russia. The French had taken over Wittgenstein years before so the peasants were subject to both heavy taxes and conscription.

5. vii. Maria Amalia Riedesel was born on January 18, 1789 in Wunderthausen. She died on March 19, 1846 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Philipp Schneider on May 05, 1811 in Wunderthausen. He was born on September 21, 1788 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 22, 1838 in Wunderthausen.

Born in the house Unter der Leye. Neither he nor his wife inherited a tenancy so it is unclear where or how they lived.

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. The records show her traveling to America as "Pott" and with a child in 1818. Her husband (to be) left at the same time, but it appears that they were not married at the time they applied to emigrate. The child was certainly the son known later as Johannes Riedesel or Rittase.

Notes for Johannes Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels Haus, Wunderthausen. Came to Pennsylvania in 1818 where he was known as John Rittase. They farmed near Hanover, York County before moving to a farm in Union Township, Adams County. He is buried at Christ Church near Littlestown, PA, in Adams County with the following inscription:

born Sept. 15, 1787
in the canton of
Wittgenstein in the
kingdom of Prussia
and being a citizen
of America for the
last 40 years
died Nov. 3, 1855

It appears that the family eventually agreed on "Rittase" and used that spelling consistently thereafter. Church records when their children were young used some variation on "Riedes." It was a German-speaking congregation and one might have expected the proper name to have endured, but that was not the case. "Rittase" sounds very much like the Wittgenstein pronunciation of "Riedesel" except for dropping the final "L". Everyone with this name appears to trace back to John.

Notes for Johann Ludwig Homrighausen:

He was born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen. He inherited it from his father, but it may have had little if any agricultural land. In his early youth he was employed as a shepherd in neighboring Diedenshausen and then as teacher in the small settlements at Dachsloch and Langewiese. However, in 1833 he began what would be a lifetime of employment as one of the school teachers in Diedenshausen. His family continued to live in Wunderthausen (2km away), but during school he was only there two nights a week.

Originally, his compensation was mostly in grain though he was later paid a cash salary. It was meagre, and like most men in the region he pursued a side craft to help make ends meet. Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier

- vii. Anna Catherine Riedesel was born on April 22, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 11, 1909 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). She married Johann Georg Riedesel in 1837. He was born on November 13, 1810 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 31, 1894 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).

Notes for Anna Catherine Riedesel:

Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." In other sources it is listed as Radle.

She appears to have been known as Mary Catherine.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Born in Seimes/Weißkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1834. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They went to America and settled at Oxford, New Jersey (now Hazen) in 1837; the name of their ship or exact travel dates are not known. Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant.

At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations. Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. A transcription of the New Jersey death record lists him as "J. George Riddle." That source gives his year of death as 1893. His grave marker says 1884. Other family trees say 1894 which I am accepting for now but any of the dates is possible.

- viii. Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born on May 13, 1817 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 27, 1903 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel:

Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born May 13, 1817, in Wunderthausen in the house known as Wetzels. He was the eighth of nine recorded children of Johann Ludwig and Anna Elisabeth (Knoche) Riedesel.

An older sister, Catherine, came to live in Warren County, New Jersey in 1837. Ludwig's application for naturalization states that he arrived in 1841 and that is the year he received permission to emigrate. He married Caroline Schaeffer (probably Schäfer) around 1845. She was born August 16, 1824 in Germany. One source gives Wunderthausen as her place of birth but this is unlikely. No Schäfer daughter is recorded in the birth records at this time--and no Schäfer family even lived in the village. Nor were they married there.

Several of the Riedesels who settled in Warren County came to be known as Riddle or Radle. It's not that there weren't other Germans around who could pronounce (and spell) Riedesel correctly, but this seemed to be the rule. Ludwig (or Louis) farmed near what was called Oxford Furnace. Ludwig finally received his naturalization papers in 1854 as "Ludwig Readle" though his signature says "Riedesel." He is buried as "Ludwig Riddle."

They had at least seven children before Caroline died in 1867. Four of their children are buried with them. The family name of his second wife Catherine is not known to me. Some have identified her as another Riedesel/Riddle by birth but that is almost certainly in error. There were three children that we know of from the marriage with Catherine.

Notes for Caroline Matilda Schaeffer:

There are claims that she came from Wunderthausen but there is no sign of her in the quite-complete local church records. There was no Schaeffer/Schäfer/Scheffer families in the village at all. Another source names her father as "Christian Allen." The first name was rare in Wittgenstein while "Allen" did not exist there. Their daughter Louisa's death certificate from 1912 gives her name as "Clara Scheffer." If accurate, that is probably just a family nickname.

Notes for Catherine ??:

This Catherine has often been mistaken for another Riedesel/Riddle--by me among others--specifically a Catherine Riddle born in 1839 to Wunderthausen immigrants. The 1880 Census, however, shows that this woman was born in Bavaria about 1832. She is listed with her husband and family in the 1880 Federal Census but is not listed in the 1885 New Jersey Census and you must assume she had died. The grave marker for Catherine Riddle in the Hazen cemetery (d. August 08, 1917) belongs to the Catherine Riddle born in 1839 who never married. There is a Find-a-Grave entry for the latter but I think the birth year of 1832 is in error.

- ix. Anna Elisabeth Riedesel was born on February 20, 1819 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 03, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Franz Homrighausen on April 26, 1840 in Wunderthausen. Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen:

Known as Franz. Born in Räderhaase/Haasebergers Haus in Wunderthausen. He apparently served some time in the Prussian army as he was later a member of a German veterans association in nearby Lowden. Came to Crawford County, Ohio with the extended Riedesel family. They had arrived in New York out of Bremen on June 7, 1845. The family moved on to what became the Wheatland community by 1857. According to the 1911 memorial booklet celebrating the 50th anniversary of the founding of St. Paul's church in Wheatland, he had been a founder of the previous congregation in 1857.

By the time of his death, he owned 536 acres of farmland at Wheatland (in Sections 27, 28 and 33 of the Spring Rock Township). He was clearly a prosperous farmer and a respected elder in the German community and church. Though his two wives had the same given names, they were not that closely related. His one child with his first wife died a few months after she did in 1843.

The three sons each took over part of his substantial farm.

Notes for Georg Gabriel Riedesel:

Married into Wetezels house and later to Weymers Haus from Gundermanns. Through his two marriages he is the progenitor of a large majority of Riedesels in the U.S. He is sometimes listed as Johann Gabriel, but was in any case almost certainly known as Gabriel.
