Mrs. Ebbert, second wife of Mr. Carl Ebbert, died at her home, three miles south of Wheatland, Saturday, February 24, 1894, at four o'clock, a. m., at the age of 74 years 8 months and 8 days.

The deceased was a most estimable woman, a faithful wife and mother, who is deeply mourned by a sorrowing and bereaved family. She was the mother of four children: Henry, George and Anna Fey, of this township; and Phillip Fey, of Baltimore, Md.

The funeral services were held at the German Reform church at this place Monday forenoon and were conducted by Rev. C. G. Zips. A large number of sorrowing friends were in attendance at the funeral and also followed the remains to their last resting place in the cemetery.
