Was working in the mines at the time. One family account says that he died young from homesickness.

- Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein, son of Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein and Maria Elisabeth Strackbein, was born on November 18, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 12, 1869 in Wunderthausen. He married Anna Elisabeth Pott on July 28, 1844 in Wunderthausen.
- 3. **Anna Elisabeth Pott**, daughter of Johannes Pott and Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel, was born on November 27, 1822 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 28, 1872 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein: Born in and became the tenant in Kurts Haus.

Anna Elisabeth Pott and Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein had the following children:

 Johannes Strackbein was born on June 02, 1845 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 17, 1933 in New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen on March 10, 1872 in Wunderthausen. She was born on May 22, 1850 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 17, 1909 in Warren County, New Jersey (Belvidere Cemetery, Warren County, NJ).

Notes for Johannes Strackbein: Born in Mannes Haus, Wunderthausen. Emigrated to Oxford, New Jersey in 1872 according to the 1920 Census. As of 1880 he was working at a blast furnace. Naturalized 1877.

Notes for Maria Elisabeth Homrighausen: Born in Brückeschneiders Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to the U.S. with her husband in 1872.

ii. Anna Elisabeth Strackbein was born on April 25, 1849. She married Johann Georg Homrighausen on April 02, 1871 in Wunderthausen. He was born on February 22, 1841 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 08, 1909 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Georg Homrighausen: Born in Lipses Haus, Wunderthausen.

iii. Catherine Strackbein was born on April 04, 1851 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 23, 1910 in Wunderthausen. She married Georg Ludwig Homrighausen on January 03, 1875. He was born on April 24, 1850 in Wunderthausen. He died on December 12, 1906 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Georg Ludwig Homrighausen: Born in Wetzels, became resident of Mannes after his marriage.

iv. Johann Georg Strackbein was born on May 09, 1854 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 13, 1937 in Sioux City, Woodbury, Iowa. He married Lorraine Schmidt on February 05, 1885 in Cedar County, Iowa. She was born on September 19, 1862 in Iowa. She died on December 04, 1947. Notes for Johann Georg Strackbein:

Born in Mannes Haus, Wunderthausen. Family records say that he came to America in 1881, and that he lived successively in New Jersey, Wheatland, Midway, Battle Creek, and Sioux City (the latter all in Iowa). Around Wheatland he was known as "Big George" to distinguish him from two other George Strackbeins.

He is probably the George Strackbein who arrived in New York on the ship Salier on October 4, 1881. The obituary suggests a later arrival, but is not necessarily any more accurate.

The Anthon Herald, 18 August 1937, page 1:

George Strackbein, a former Anthon resident, died at 8:45 p.m. Friday, August 13, 1937, at his home in Sioux City at the age of 83 years, 3 months and 9 days. Death was caused by complications incident to old age. While his health began to fail in the spring he did not become bedfast until a week before his demise. Born May 4, 1854, at Westphalia, Germany, he came to the United States in 1882 and settled in Cedar Co., Iowa. A year later he moved to Woodbury County but returned to Lowden in Cedar County to marry Miss Lorraine Schmidt in February 1885. The couple took up farming near Anthon and all their married life was spent in Woodbury County. A hard worker, Mr. Strackbein saved enough so he could retire from farming in 1911. He built a house in Anthon where they lived until 1921 when they moved to Sioux City, where the remainder of his life was spent. He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church while residing in the Anthon community and became affiliated with Concordia Lutheran Church in Sioux City. In 1910, Mr. Strackbein made a trip to his old home in Germany and spent four months in his native land. He enjoyed this trip immensely and liked to speak of his experiences there. At the same time he visited his brother John, now deceased, in New Jersey. Survivors include the widow of Sioux City, two sons, Carl of Sioux City and Leon of Tacoma, Washington; two daughters, Mrs. Pete Petersen and Mrs. Jens Petersen of east of Anthon, 11 grandchildren and one great grandchild. Funeral services were held at 1 p.m. Monday in the Nelson Berger Funeral Chapel in Sioux City with Rev. G.A. Matthaidess officiating. The remains were taken to St. Paul Lutheran Church at Midway where rites were conducted at 3 p.m. by Rev. Matthaidess. Interment was made in the Midway Cemetery. Burial: Saint Paul Lutheran Cemetery Midway (Woodbury County).

Notes for Lorraine Schmidt:

By 1900 she had borne 7 children, but only three were living. Leon was yet to follow.

Known as Fred. Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. Came to the US on the ship Salier out of Bremen, landing in New York on October 4, 1881. According to his obituary, he farned at first in New Jersey, spent at least some time at Wheatland, but lived the better part of 40 years in Woodbury County, Iowa.

Notes for Lucia Broderson: Came to the U.S. in 1880.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein: Lived at Kurts Haus in Wunderthausen.

Born in Kurts Haus in Wunderthausen. The records are not clear but it appears that he came to America in 1860 and settled in Pennsylvania. According to one source he died in April 1905 and is buried in the Kizer Cemetery in Jefferson, Pennsylvania, but I can find no record there. He was married to Louise Wagner and had at least three children.

viii. Maria Elisabeth Strackbein was born on June 17, 1839 in Wunderthausen. She died on April 11, 1880 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Franz Homrighausen on July 16, 1865 in Wunderthausen. He was born on July 05, 1836 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 12, 1909 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johann Franz Homrighausen: Lived in Schäfers.

- Johannes Pott, son of Johannes Pott and Maria Elisabeth Klein, was born on April 01, 1789 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 22, 1856 in Wunderthausen. He married Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel on August 03, 1823 in Wunderthausen.
- 7. **Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel**, daughter of Johann Ludwig Riedesel and Anna Elisabeth Knoche, was born on March 23, 1803 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 08, 1878 in

Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Pott:

Born in and became the tenant in Mannes Haus.

Elisabeth Wilhelmine Riedesel and Johannes Pott had the following children:

- Anna Elisabeth Pott was born on November 27, 1822 in Wunderthausen. She died on May 28, 1872 in Wunderthausen. She married Ludwig Heinrich Strackbein on July 28, 1844 in Wunderthausen. He was born on November 18, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on October 12, 1869 in Wunderthausen.
 - Catherine Elisabeth Pott was born on January 09, 1825 in Wunderthausen. She died on December 18, 1902 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Georg Lauber on July 04, 1847 in Wunderthausen. He was born on November 24, 1818 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 12, 1912 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Catherine Elisabeth Pott: Born in Mannes house.

Notes for Johann Georg Lauber: Founded the house "Im Gründchen" outside of Wunderthausen though was born in Hohmanns.

iii. Johannes Pott was born on January 08, 1827 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 10, 1913 in Hazen, Warren, New Jersey (Hillside Cemetery, Oxford). He married Christiana Hirt about 1860. She was born in 1841 in Berne, Switzerland. She died in 1906 (Hillside Cemetery, Oxford).

Notes for Johannes Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. He arrived in New York on the ship Centurion out of Antwerp in 1852. Living in the Oxford, NJ, area in the late 1890s. He is described as having been a big man in family records. Living with his brother, George, at the time of the 1860 Census and was apparently single then; occupation was that of a miner. He eventually became known as "Potts" as did his sons.

- iv. Elisabeth Amalia Pott was born on November 25, 1828 in Wunderthausen. She died on June 09, 1901 in Wunderthausen. She married Johannes Strackbein on June 12, 1853 in Wunderthausen. He was born on August 17, 1824 in Wunderthausen. He died on June 12, 1863 in Wunderthausen.
- v. Anna Catherine Pott was born on February 13, 1831 in Wunderthausen. She died on July 18, 1910 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. She married Johann Franz Schneider on August 03, 1854 in America. He was born on October 27, 1829 in Wunderthausen. He died on July 10, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Anna Catherine Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. Arrived in New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen on July 19, 1854. Though they were not married until a month after landing, the passenger list (but not the German permission files) gives her last name as Schenider. Her name was on the family farm near Wheatland as of 1894; another large tract in Section 20 is also listed as belonging to "Mrs. F. Schneider." That may have been her but maybe not.

Notes for Johann Franz Schneider:

Known as Franz. Born in the Wunderthausen house called Hanphilippses. Came to New York on the ship "Rio Packet" out of Bremen and arrived on July 19, 1854. The passenger list gives Anna's name as Schneider and lists baby Anna. Perhaps they married in Germany and had another ceremony in the U.S. Perhaps not. He was a deacon in the first Kirchenrat (Board) of St. Paul's church in 1861 as was one of his brothers (uncertain which). As late as July of 1860 (Census), he was living in Warren County, NJ, next to the Pott brothers. He owned farmland in Sections 15, 22 and 23 of the Spring Rock Township.

vi. Johann Georg Pott was born on July 13, 1834 in Wunderthausen. He died on August 10, 1913 in Hazen, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Mary Johanna Glashner on April 18, 1872. She was born about 1840 in Weimar. She died in 1922 (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). He married Elisabeth Leinbach on April 16, 1858. She was born on July 28, 1835 in Prussia. She died on March 10, 1872 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey.

Notes for Johann Georg Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus, Wunderthausen. German records confirm that he came to America on the ship Rio Packet out of Bremen, landing in New York on July 19, 1854. That record says he was bound for Kentucky and had a child (unnamed) with him.

Lived in Warren County, NJ. Known as George. Naturalized in September, 1859. His death certificate says that he died of apoplexy.

Notes for Mary Johanna Glashner: Her name may have been Glasner.

Notes for Elisabeth Leinbach:

Records of the Jonestown Hillside Cemetery, Warren Co NJ list an "Eliza Potts", wife of George, who was born July 28, 1828, and died March 18, 1872. This could be the same woman but the details differ.

vii. Wilhelmine Pott was born on October 07, 1836 in Wunderthausen. She married Johann Heinrich Althaus on November 23, 1866 in Elsoff. He was born on February 16, 1839 in Beddelhausen.

Notes for Wilhelmine Pott: Born in Mannes Haus in Wunderthausen. She was supposed to have gone to America but that is incorrect.

- viii. Georg Ludwig Pott was born on February 02, 1839 in Wunderthausen. He died on May 01, 1839 in Wunderthausen.
- ix. Luise Florentine Pott was born on August 21, 1840 in Wunderthausen. She died on August 05, 1900 in Wunderthausen.
- x. Elisabeth Pott was born on May 14, 1843 in Wunderthausen. She died on January 03, 1892 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland). She married Georg Heinrich Dickel on February 11, 1872 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa. He was born on December 02, 1830 in Girkhausen. He died on March 05, 1917 in Wheatland, Clinton, Iowa (St. Paul's Cemetery, Wheatland).

Notes for Elisabeth Pott:

Born in Mannes Haus, Wundethausen. Came to the U.S. on the ship Deutschland, landing in New York on October 10, 1868.

Notes for Georg Heinrich Dickel:

Known as Henry. Born in the house called Zwistmühle, a single Hof between Neuastenberg and Girkhausen. At the time of his birth, the mill belonged to the parish and community of Girkhausen. Only following a modern reorganization is the property officially tied to the village of Neuastenberg in the town of Winterberg in the Hochsauerland Kreis.

Came to America on the ship "Jupiter" out of Bremen, landing in New York on June 11, 1867. With his brother he owned 80 acres in Section 5 of the Spring Rock Township of Clinton County. His older son, Carl/Charles, eventually took over the farm.

Notes for Johann Sebastian Strackbein:

Born in Kurts Haus in Wunderthausen. Known as Sebastian. Went to America in 1829 according to one history, but the archives in Wittgenstein say it was 1818. The family settled in what was then the independent burg of Jamaica, New York. They were members of a Dutch Reformed church. The service language may or may not have still been Dutch, but this denomination was theologically close to that of the German Reformed church. Later family members apparently used the spelling "Strockbine" which is actually close to the German pronunciation.

Notes for Florentine Strackbein:

Born in Gundermanns Haus in Wunderthausen. Apparently came to America in 1818. That house was demolished to make room for the first school building in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Johannes Strackbein:

Born in Kurts house, Wunderthausen. Built Schäfers house in Diedenshausen around 1830. The feudal system was in the process of being phased out, so they may have been among the first freeholders. The land came from Anna's family. Johannes worked as a shepherd for the village. This was a marginal job, said to be above a swineherd but lower than the cowherd.

xi. Anna Elisabeth Strackbein was born on October 17, 1804 in Wunderthausen. She married Ludwig Heinrich Pott on December 17, 1837. He was born on December 26, 1806 in Wunderthausen.

Notes for Anna Elisabeth Strackbein:

She was born in Kurts Haus. While apparently married in Germany, she is listed as 'Strackbein' in the list of passengers on the the ship Diana that arrived out of Bremen in New Orleans on June 2, 1841. There is no credible record of the family after that.

Notes for Ludwig Heinrich Pott:

Born in Brückeweymers Haus in Wunderthausen. He went to America on the ship "Themis" arriving in Baltimore out of Bremen on July 24, 1834. In 1837 he returned to Wunderthausen and married Anna Elisabeth. He returned to the U.S. via New Orleans on the ship "Diana", arriving there on June 2, 1841; Anna Elisabeth is listed separately and under her own name. I have found nothing more about them.

- 10. **Johann Georg Strackbein**, son of Johannes Strackbein and Anna Catharina Riedesel, was born on December 23, 1752 in Wunderthausen. He died on March 16, 1822 in Wunderthausen. He married **Elisabeth Amalia Mörchen** on April 23, 1779 in Wunderthausen.

Referred to as Anna Amalia in some records but she was christened Elisabeth Amalia. Born at the Wunderthausen mill.

Born in Wetzels Haus, Wunderthausen. Came to Pennsylvania in 1818 where he was known as John Rittase. They farmed near Hanover, York County before moving to a farm in Union Township, Adams County. He is buried at Christ Church near Littlestown, PA, in Adams County with the following inscription:

In memory of JOHN RITTASE born Sept. 15,1787 in the canton of Wittgenstein in the kingdom of Prussia and being a citizen of America for the last 40 years died Nov. 3, 1855

It appears that the family eventually agreed on "Rittase" and used that spelling consistently thereafter. Church records when their children were young used some variation on "Riedes." It was a German-speaking congregation and one might have expected the proper name to have endured, but that was not the case. "Rittase" sounds very much like the Wittgenstein pronunciation of "Riedesel" except for dropping the final "L". Everyone with this name appears to trace back to John.

He was born in Brückeschneiders house in Wunderthausen. He inherited it from his father, but it may have had little if any agricultural land. In his early youth he was employed as a shepherd in neighboring Diedenshausen and then as teacher in the small settlements at Dachsloch and Langewiese. However, in 1833 he began what would be a lifetime of employment as one of the school teachers in Diedenshausen. His family continued to live in Wunderthausen (2km away), but during school he was only there two nights a week.

Originally, his compensation was mostly in grain though he was later paid a cash salary. It was meagre, and like most men in the region he pursued a side craft to help make ends meet. Homrighausen carved spoons, a common trade in Wunderthausen. His birthday was the same as that of Kaiser Wilhelm I, which was a great source of pride.

He married twice. All five children of his first marriage died in childhood, and his wife died shortly after the birth of the last child. The children of his marriage to Amalia Riedesel were healthier

vii. Anna Catherine Riedesel was born on April 22, 1815 in Wunderthausen. She died on September 11, 1909 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). Born in Wetzels house in Wunderthausen. Married her husband in Germany in 1837 and came to America that year, according to family records. The 1900 Census gives her name as "Riddle." In other sources it is listed as Radle.

She appears to have been known as Mary Catherine.

Notes for Johann Georg Riedesel:

Born in Seimes/Weisßkopf Haus in Wunderthausen but went to America in 1837, reportedly after being discharged from military service in 1834. He and Catherine were married in Germany in 1837, but not in the Girkhausen parish of which their native Wunderthausen was a part. They went to America and settled at Oxford, New Jersey (now Hazen) in 1837; the name of their ship or exact travel dates are not known. Much of the information about the family is taken from a family Bible that was transcribed by a descendant.

At least by the children's generation, they had settled on the name of "Riddle" though there are references to other variations. Known as George--sometimes Ritesel, sometimes Radle, sometimes Riddle. A transcription of the New Jersey death record lists him as "J. George Riddle." That source gives his year of death

as 1893. His grave marker says 1884. Other family trees say 1894 which I am accepting for now but any of the dates is possible.

viii. Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born on May 13, 1817 in Wunderthausen. He died on February 27, 1903 in Oxford, Warren, New Jersey (Hazen Cemetery, Warren County, NJ). Notes for Georg Ludwig Riedesel:

Georg Ludwig Riedesel was born May 13, 1817, in Wunderthausen in the house known as Wetzels. He was the eighth of nine recorded children of Johann Ludwig and Anna Elisabeth (Knoche) Riedesel.

An older sister, Catherine, came to live in Warren County, New Jersey in 1837. Ludwig's application for naturalization states that he arrived in 1841 and that is the year he received permission to emigrate. He married Caroline Schaeffer (probably Schäfer) around 1845. She was born August 16, 1824 in Germany. One source gives Wunderthausen as her place of birth but this is unlikely. No Schäfer daughter is recorded in the birth records at this time--and no Schäfer family even lived in the village. Nor were they married there.

Several of the Riedesels who settled in Warren County came to be known as Riddle or Radle. It's not that there weren't other Germans around who could pronounce (and spell) Riedesel correctly, but this seemed to be the rule. Ludwig (or Louis) farmed near what was called Oxford Furnace. Ludwig finally received his naturalization papers in 1854 as "Ludwig Readle" though his signature says "Riedesel." He is buried as "Ludwig Riddle."

They had at least seven children before Caroline died in 1867. Four of their children are buried with them. The family name of his second wife Catherine is not known to me. Some have identified her as another Riedesel/Riddle by birth but that is almost certainly in error. There were three children that we know of from the marriage with Catherine.

Notes for Caroline Matilda Schaeffer:

There are claims that she came from Wunderthausen but there is no sign of her in the quite-complete local church records. There was no Schaeffer/Schäfer/Scheffer families in the village at all. Another source names her father as "Christian Allen." The first name was rare in Wittgenstein while "Allen" did not exist there. Their daughter Louisa's death certificate from 1912 gives her name as "Clara Scheffer." If accurate, that is probably just a family nickname.

Notes for Catherine ??:

This Catherine has often been mistaken for another Riedesel/Riddle--by me among others--specifically a Catherine Riddle born in 1839 to Wunderthausen immigrants. The 1880 Census, however, shows that this woman was born in Bavaria about 1832. She is listed with her husband and family in the 1880 Federal Census but is not listed in the 1885 New Jersey Census and you must assume she had died. The grave marker for Catherine Riddle in the Hazen cemetery (d. August 08, 1917) belongs to the Catherine Riddle born in 1839 who never married. There is a Find-a-Grave entry for the latter but I think the birth year of 1832 is in error.

Came to Crawford County, Ohio with the extended Riedesel family. They had arrived in New York out of Bremen on June 7, 1845. The family moved on to what became the Wheatland community by 1857. According to the 1911 memorial booklet celebrating the 50th anniversary of the founding of St. Paul's church in Wheatland, he had been a founder the of the previous congregation in 1857.

By the time of his death, he owned 536 acres of farmland at Wheatland (in Sections 27, 28 and 33 of the Spring Rock Township). He was clearly a prosperous farmer and a respected elder in the German community and church. Though his two wives had the same given names, they were not that closely related. His one child with his first wife died a few months after she did in 1843.

The three sons each took over part of his substantial farm.
